**GAME 11 STORYLINES**

**1. SENIORS FINISH CAREER:** The Eagles have a large contingent of 15 seniors making their final appearances for Eastern Michigan University in Saturday's (Nov. 19) 2005 season finale at the University at Buffalo.

**2. DESLAURIERS OUT TO BREAK THE TIE:** EMU junior wide receiver **Eric Deslauriers (Gatineau, Quebec, Canada)** tied the EMU career record for touchdown receptions when he hauled in a 40-yard **Matt Bohnet** pass for a touchdown in the third quarter of last weekend's one-point loss to Ball State (Nov. 12). The touchdown catch was Deslauriers' 20th of his career tying him with current Cincinnati Bengals' receiver **Kevin Walter** who had 20 touchdown receptions from 1999-2002. Deslauriers has now played in 33 games for the Eagles, and has recorded receptions in 22 straight games.

**3. FIRST TRIP TO BUFFALO:** EMU will be making its first trip to Buffalo Saturday (Nov. 19) when the Eagles and Bulls square off in a 1:30 p.m. Mid-American Conference matchup. EMU has a 2-0 lead in the series with both games played in Ypsilanti. Last year EMU came up with a late fourth-quarter score to secure a 37-34 win in the season opener, Sept. 2. The Eagles also hosted Buffalo in 2001, notching a 24-20 win, Oct. 27.

**WEMU89.1**

All 2005 EMU football games will be broadcast live on WEMU-FM (89.1) in Ypsilanti, Mich. and on WDTW (1310 AM) in Detroit. **Matt Shepard** will handle the play-by-play duties with **Rob Rubick** serving as the analyst. **Jeff Fulton** is the engineer and the man on statistics while **Brian Nemerovski** will be the spotter. Shepard is in his third consecutive season with the broadcast crew after serving as play-by-play man in 1999. Rubick is in his seventh year. **BALL STATE COMEBACK SPELLS DOOM FOR EAGLES**

**YPSILANTI, Mich.**--The Eastern Michigan University football team was the victim of a furious fourth-quarter Ball State rally that ended in a 26-25 setback for the Eagles here Saturday (Nov. 12) night in Rynearson Stadium.

The visiting Cardinals, down by a 22-7 count with just over seven minutes left in the game, scored 19 unanswered points and held EMU scoreless the rest of the way to successfully pull off the comeback victory.

The winning score came on a touchdown pass with just 00:12 left in the game, with the Cardinals missing the two-point conversion for the 26-25 win.

For EMU, now 3-6 overall and 2-5 in Mid-American Conference action, the loss was tough to take as the Eagles rolled up 493 yards on 85 plays while Ball State accumulated just 237 yards on 55 plays.

The loss also spoiled several outstanding performances by EMU players, including:

- **Eric Deslauriers (Gatineau, Quebec, Ontario-Lennoxville Prep)** tied the EMU career record for touchdown receptions when he hauled in a 40-yard **Matt Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge)** pass for a score in the second quarter. That catch tied **Kevin Walter** (1999-2002) for the record at 20 TD catches.

- For Bohnet, that 40-yard touchdown strike to Deslauriers was the 33rd of his career, tying **Robert Middlekauff (1951-54)** for third on the EMU career list.

- Placekicker **Andrew Wellock (North Canton, Ohio-Green)** connected on field goals of 27, 32, 47 and 37 to tie the EMU single-game record at four, held by five players. Wellock has booted four field goals in three games during his career.

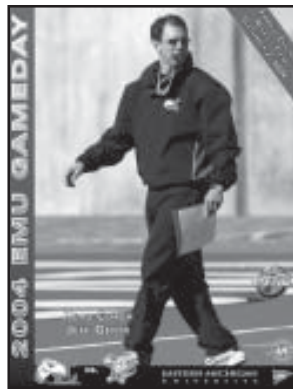

**EAGLES TAKE SEASON-OPENING 37-34 WIN OVER BUFFALO**

**YPSILANTI-** -The Eastern Michigan University football team found a great way to usher in the **Jeff Genyk** era — with a thrilling 37-34 victory over a visiting University at Buffalo team here Thursday night in Rynearson Stadium.

The Eagles not only gave first-year Head Coach Genyk his first win, which was also his first Mid-American Conference win, but they did it in front of a good opening-game crowd of 17,750, and also a live television crowd in the southeast Michigan area courtesy of Comcast Local.

The Eagles and Buffalo had to overcome some opening-game jitters which resulted in five fumbles by both teams, four by EMU, along with two interceptions by EMU of Buffalo quarterbacks.

The Eagles used several exciting ways to record the win, including an 82-yard fumble return by defensive back **Jerry Gaines (Plymouth, Mich.-Canton)**, and a 49-yard personal best field goal by **Andrew Wellock (North Canton, Ohio-Green)**.

Junior quarterback **Matt Bohnet (Grand Ledge, Mich.-Grand Ledge)** saw his first collegiate action in two years after transferring from the University of Iowa, and he responded with a solid performance, rushing for 92 yards on 23 carries and completing 11-of-20 passes for 91 yards and two touchdown throws.

Senior tailback **Anthony Sherrell (Roseville, Mich.-Orchard Lake St. Mary's)** turned in his ninth straight 100-plus rushing effort, including the last eight games of 2003, with 151 yards on 24 carries, while also scoring on a seven-yard touchdown run.

The Eagles built a 27-21 halftime lead on the return by Gaines, the seven-yard run by Sherrell, an eight-yard pass from Bohnet to tight end **Adam Jacobs (East Lansing, Mich.-East Lansing)** and two field goals, of 37 and 49 yards, by Wellock.

Wellock added his third field goal of the game, a 28-yarder, in the third quarter to give the Eagles a 30-21 lead, but the Bulls came back with two unanswered touchdowns to forge a 34-30 lead with 14:35 left in the game.

Eastern's offense then marched 65 yards to retake the lead at 37-34 on a five-yard touchdown pass from Bohnet to **Chris Talley (Romulus, Mich.-Romulus)** with 7:52 remaining, with Wellock adding the PAT.

From that point the defense rallied to stop Buffalo on three consecutive possessions to allow the Eagles to record the three-point win.

Defensively the Eagles were led by senior linebacker **Kevin Harrison (Belleville, Mich.-Belleville)** with 18 stops while safety **Rontrell Woodruff (Southfield, Mich.-Lathrup)** had 10. Gaines and **Keyvon Barbee (Pontiac, Mich.-Orchard Lake St. Mary's)** added nine stops each.

**SECOND TIME FOR DOUBLE 100'S:** EMU wide receivers **Eric Deslauriers (Gatineau, Ontario, Canada-Lennoxville Prep)** and **A.J. Bennett (Delray Beach, Fla.-Atlantic Community)** both turned in double-figure receiving games against Western Michigan, Nov. 5. Deslauriers caught 14 passes for 166 yards and one touchdown and Bennett snagged 13 receptions for 122 yards. The only other time that two EMU receivers have had double figures in catches and 100+ yards in receiving was Nov. 11, 2000 against Northern Illinois when **Kevin Walter** had 14 catches for 199 yards and one score and **Kenny Chrtistan** added 10 receptions for 116 yards.

**GAGNON-GORDILLO AND WELLOCK WIN NCAA MENTION:**

Senior defensive lineman **Olivier Gagnon-Gordillo (Charlesbourg, Quebec, Canada-Champlain)** and junior placekicker **Andrew Wellock (North Canton, Ohio-Green)** have been selected to the 2005 *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District IV University Division Football Team. Gagnon-Gordillo has a 3.48 GPA as a graduate student in human resources. He completed his undergraduate degree in April 2004. Wellock has a 3.79 GPA as a management major. Gagnon-Gordillo, who was also a second-team All-District Academic pick in 2004, has recorded 36 total tackles this season, and is third on the team in tackles-for-loss with 6.5 for 29 yards. Wellock has made 17-of-24 field goals and his 52 career three pointers ranks first in EMU history.

**PRIME TIME IN THE CITY:** Redshirt freshman wide receiver **Christopher Graham (Detroit, Mich.-Cody)** picked a great time to have a career game. Returning home to Detroit for the Collegiate Clash between EMU-WMU at Ford Field (Nov. 5) in Detroit. **SHOWING THE HOMETOWN TEAM:** Redshirt sophomore wide receiver **Travis Lewis (Kalamazoo, Mich.-Loy Norrix)** played his high school football in Western Michigan University's home town and he recorded the first touchdown reception of his career with a 27-yard grab against the Broncos (Nov. 5) at Ford Field. He finished with five grabs for 55 yards.

**BENNETT OVER A GRAND:** Senior wide receiver **A.J. Bennett** has moved over the 1,000-yard career receiving mark with 1,159 yards gained on 109 catches. He has scored six career touchdowns. Bennett had his biggest game as an Eagle against Western Michigan (Nov. 5) when he grabbed 13 Matt Bohnet passes for 122 yards in a 44-36 loss to the Broncos.

Freshman redshirt quarterback **Tyler Jones** gained 107 yards on 19 carries and senior tailback **Anthony Sherrell** tallied 107 yards on 12 carries. The last time EMU had two rushers over 100 yards was the 1975 season when **Rod Slater** (21-130) and **Carl Hughes** (22-119) recorded 100-yard games, Sept. 20, 1975 at NE Louisiana (now Louisiana Monroe). **A GAME OF FIRSTS:** Senior **Rontrell Woodruff** recorded the first reception of his career when he caught an **Andrew Wellock** pass on a fake punt for 24 yards that resulted in an EMU first down at Toledo (Oct. 7). It was also Wellock's first completion in two attempts. He had one incomplete pass last year, against Bowling Green (Oct. 30, 2004).

**MAC AWARDS:** Several EMU players have been singled by the Mid-American Conference for special honors in 2005. Freshman middle linebacker **Daniel Holtzclaw (Enid, Okla.-Enid)** was named Mid-American Conference West Division Defensive Player of the Week for the week ending Oct. 2. also earned the same award in voting on the website *MAC Sports Online*. Sophomore **Blake Smith (Detroit, Mich.-Mackenzie)** was a special-teams demon, Sept. 10, against Louisiana-Lafayette and was named Mid-American Conference Special Teams Player of the Week for his efforts. Senior quarterback **Matt Bohnet** and junior placekicker **Andrew Wellock** were both singled out for Mid-American Conference awards for the week ending Sept. 24. Bohnet was named the MAC's men's Scholar-Athlete of the Week and Wellock was named MAC West Division Special Teams Player of the Week for outstanding efforts in a 23-20 overtime win at CMU (Sept. 24).

**AVENGING A BIG LOSS:** The Eagles were able to avenge one of the biggest losses in school history in the annual Homecoming Game (Oct. 1). Eastern traveled to Kent, Ohio in 2004 and dropped a 69-17 decision to the Golden Flashes. The 2005 meeting was a different story, however, as Eastern raced to an early 27-7 lead and held on for a 27-20 victory over KSU in Rynearson.

**MICHIGAN MAC PLAQUE PRESENTED:** Prior to the start of the EMU-Louisiana-Lafayette game, Sept. 10, **Jim Stark**, the executive director of the state of Michigan Sports Hall of Fame, presented EMU Head Coach **Jeff Genyk** with a plaque honoring the Eagles as the champions of the 2004 Michigan Mid-American Conference battle between Eastern, Western and Central Michigan. Eastern defeated both WMU and CMU in league contests last year, the first time since 1986 that EMU defeated both teams in the same season. The future champions of the Michigan MAC Championship will receive a trophy from the state of Michigan Sports Hall of Fame. The Eagles took the first step towards winning the first trophy with a 23-20 overtime win at CMU (Sept. 24), but last weekend (Nov. 5) WMU ended EMU's hopes of capturing the 2005 award with a 44-36 win over the Eagles. WMU will hold the trophy for at least a year after defeating Central Michigan, 31-24, (Nov. 12) in Kalamazoo.

**HOMECOMING WIN:** The 27-20 win over Kent State (Oct. 1) came on EMU's 2005 Homecoming Game. The last time EMU won a Homecoming tilt was the 2002 season when the Eagles defeated the NCAA Division I-AA Salukis of Southern Illinois, 48-45, in double overtime (Sept. 28). The last time an EMU squad defeated an NCAA I-A opponent on Homecoming was 1995 when the Eagles recorded a 31-20 victory over Ohio (Sept. 23).

**TWO-WAY MAN:** Sophomore **Duan Bracey (Detroit, Mich.-Murray Wright)** became the first two-way player for EMU since **Kenny Christian** pulled off the feat in 1999. Bracey started at cornerback on defense and wide receiver on offense in the season opener Thursday, Sept. 1, at Cincinnati. Bracey did not catch a pass but had three tackles on defense. Christian played both wide receiver and defensive back during the 1999 season.

**LOWEST SINCE '98:** When the EMU defense held a visiting University of Louisiana-Lafayette team to just 10 points (Sept. 10) it was the first time since the 1998 season that the Eagles had held an opponent to 10 points or less. That '98 defense limited Ball State to seven points, Sept. 12, in a 13-7 victory in Muncie, Ind. and then closed the season with a 10-7 win over Toledo, Nov. 21, at home in Rynearson Stadium.

**FIRST ON THE RUSH:** When **Matt Bohnet** rushed for a three-yard touchdown run on the third offensive series of the game, Sept. 10, against Louisiana-Lafayette, it was the first rushing touchdown of his 13-game career. He then added a one-yard touchdown run in the third quarter to close out the game's scoring. Bohnet also accounted for passing touchdowns of 38 and 14 yards in the win over the Ragin' Cajuns.

**BOHNET TO BOHNET:** The Bohnet brothers teamed up for some positive yardage in the win over ULL, Sept. 10. Senior quarterback **Matt Bohnet** found tight end **Ken Bohnet** for two passes for 13 yards in the victory. The two teamed up for one pass for -1 yard in the season opener at Cincinnati (Sept. 1). **THE GRADUATES:** EMU will have three football players working on postgraduate degrees during the 2005 season. Defensive lineman **Jean Olivier Gagnon-Gordillo** graduated in April 2004, and is working on his M.A. in the MSHROD program. Defensive backs **Steven Lewis (Toledo, Ohio-Rogers)** and **Jereme Perry (Saginaw, Mich.-Buena Vista)** graduated this past summer with Lewis earning a degree in communications and Perry a bachelor's in psychology.

**EAGLES ADD NORTHWESTERN:** Eastern Michigan University and Northwestern University have agreed to play a three-game football series beginning in 2006, EMU Interim Athletics Director **Bob England** has announced.

The series is slated to begin, Sept. 16, 2006, at Ryan Field in Evanston, Ill. Eastern will then be the host team, Oct. 20, 2007, followed by the series finale in 2009, back at Ryan Field in Evanston, Ill. The 2006 game will be the first-ever meeting on the gridiron between EMU and Northwestern.

“Our coaching staff and student-athletes are looking forward to the challenge of schedules that include more Big Ten teams,” England said.

The Northwestern series adds to EMU's string of games against teams from the Big Ten Conference. The Eagles will also play Michigan (2005, 2007, 2010), Michigan State (2006, 2008, 2012) and Penn State (2009 and 2011) in the coming years.
