## GAME OVERVIEW

Geneva is coming into Saturday's contest off its bye week, while Bethany opened PAC play last Saturday with a big 52-3 victory at home over Thiel. Geneva is in the midst of a stretch of four weeks without a game at home, while Bethany is in a stretch of four of five games at home. Bethany's games have been high-scoring contests so far, with the Bison averaging 39 ppg while giving up 41 ppg. Bethany's two wins so far this year are the first time the Bison have won more one game in a season since 2019. Geneva's last game at Shenandoah two weeks ago was a frustrating one, with five first-half turnovers leading to a big deficit that the Golden Tornadoes could not overcome. Geneva will need to limit turnovers going forward.

## GENEVA GAME NOTES

-- Geneva will try to rebound from a frustrating loss at Shenandoah two weeks ago. The Golden Tornadoes were on their bye last week and will begin PAC play this week, finishing with eight conference games. Last year Geneva finished 6-2 in PAC play, its best record since joining the PAC in 2011.

-- Despite the 48-14 loss to Shenandoah two weeks ago, the Golden Tornadoes actually outgained the Hornets in yardage in the game. But five first half turnovers were a big reason for the loss.

-- A total of ten different players have caught a pass for Geneva in the first two games as the Golden Tornadoes work to replace their top three wide receivers from last year. A pair of juniors in Dayne Johnke and Will Patterson have taken on the biggest roles so far. Johnke leads the team with 14 catches for 184 yards and a TD, while Patterson has caught 12 passes for 108 yards and a score.

-- Senior quarterback Caleb Romano has thrown for over 300 yards in both games so far. He's on pace to finish in the top three in program history in passing yards, despite playing only three seasons for Geneva, one of which was in the triple option attack.

-- The Golden Tornadoes have struggled with turnovers through two games, giving the ball up nine times while forcing just one turnover defensively. Currently Geneva is -8 in turnover margin, and its -4.0 turnover margin per game average is last in Division III.

-- The Geneva defense didn't play as badly at Shenandoah as the final score indicates. The turnovers put the defense in some tough spots, and the GTs finished the game allowing 360 yards off offense while limiting Shenandoah's talented running game to just 3.6 yards per carry.

-- Junior defensive back Cody Patterson scored his first career touchdown at Shenandoah when he scooped up a blocked punt and raced 22 yards for the score. He also led the team with eight tackles.

-- Junior safety Noah Hutcherson leads the team with 16 tackles and 4.0 TFLs.

## BETHANY GAME NOTES

-- Bethany has shown notable improvement under first-year Head Coach David Blake. Blake has spent time at multiple locations over past several years, serving as an assistant at Kent State, Concord, Westminster, Bluefield State, Auburn, Rhodes and Memphis over the past ten seasons. After Bethany posted a 4-46 record over the past five seasons, Blake has taken over and has a 2-1 record through three games.

-- Bethany's offense has shined so far this year, led by junior do-it-all quarterback Brett Phillips. Phillips has thrown for 877 yards and six TDs through three games, and he also leads the team with 203 yards rushing and three scores. Phillips has also thrown just one interception in 91 passing attempts.

-- Freshman running back Anthony Stallworth has given the Bison a big boost. Stallworth originally signed to play at Division I Akron in 2022 but never appeared in a game. He resurfaced this year at Bethany and has run for 175 yards and three TDs.

-- Junior wide receiver Mykel Davis is another Division I transfer, coming from West Virginia, who is making an impact. He leads the team with 261 yards receiving, averaging 21.8 yards per reception. Junior Jacob Burns leads the team with 15 receptions and four TDs, giving Phillips a talented duo to throw to in the passing game.

-- One of the few areas offensively where Bethany has struggled some is holding onto the ball. Through three games, the Bison have fumbled seven times, losing five of them.

-- Defensively, the Bison gave up 37 points in the season-opener in a 40-37 win over Sewanee, and then Bethany gave up 84 points at Baldwin Wallace in week two. Last week the Bison allowed just three points to Thiel.

-- Geneva has won the last five matchups between these two teams.

LAST MEETING (2025)

Geneva welcomed Bethany to Reeves Field last year for Homecoming and put up one of the most historic days offensively in school history. Geneva's 75 points in the victory were second most in school history. The GTs jumped ahead 37-7 over the first 25 minutes and cruised to the huge win. Caleb Romano had one of the biggest passing days in school history, finishing with 475 yards through the air and six touchdowns. Keaton Baker was the biggest producer on the receiving end of Romano's passing, totaling 12 catches for 219 yards and two touchdowns. Geneva added three touchdowns on the ground, finishing with eight different players that scored at least one touchdown. For Bethany, quarterback Brett Phillips had a big day, with 296 yards and four touchdowns.
