THE MATCH-UP: Marist opens Pioneer Football League play with a home contest against Presbyterian as the Red Foxes host a white-out at Tenney Stadium. Kickoff is set for noon.

HOW TO FOLLOW: **Geoff Brault** (play-by-play), **Steve Eggink** (analyst), and **William Rosen** (sideline) will have the call on ESPN+. In-game updates will be available on X via Marist Football (@Marist_FBall).

OUR LEADERS: Marist has three captains this season: graduate QB **Sonny Mannino**, senior LB **Kade Werner**, and senior RB **Lincoln Cardillo**. Mannino is a captain for the second straight year, while Werner and Cardillo are both first-time captains.

MARIST IN THE NFL: **Jason Myers**, who played at Marist from 2009-12 and graduated in 2013, is in his eighth season as the Seattle Seahawks' placekicker and 12th in the NFL. Last season, Myers became a Super Bowl champion. He set the NFL record for points scored over an entire season, and Super Bowl records for most field goals and most points scored by a kicker. He has been named to the Pro Bowl twice (2018, 2022). **Connor Hulstein**, who played at Marist in 2025, was with the New York Jets this preseason. In its history, five Marist football players have signed NFL contracts.

ABOUT PRESBYTERIAN: The Blue Hose defeated UVA Wise in their season opener, and they dropped their last two to a pair of Southern Conference opponents, nationally-ranked Mercer and Western Carolina. Presbyterian went 10-2 overall and 6-2 in PFL play last season. The Blue Hose were picked to finish seventh in this year's PFL Preseason Poll, with OL **Marcello Coleman** named to the Preseason All-PFL Team. **Matt Rahl** is in his first season as head coach after having served as offensive line coach, run game coordinator, and offensive recruiting coordinator the last two years.

UP NEXT: Marist will play its first PFL road game of the season on Saturday, Oct. 3 at Stetson. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m.

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Head Coach Mike Willis

Third Season

Princeton/2014

Mike Willis was hired as the fifth head coach in the history of the Marist football program on Dec. 19, 2023. The 2026 season marks his third at Marist, as the program has made continued gains athletically, academically, and from a fundraising standpoint.

Willis' 2025 season, his second leading the program, saw the Red Foxes achieve their highest win total in 12 years while recording two wins over scholarship teams for the first time in program history. The Red Foxes had four All-Americans (Connor Hulstein, Dominic Perricone, Nate Robinson Jr., Chase Hatton). This ran their total to eight in Willis' first two seasons, the highest two-year number of All-Americans in program history. Hulstein was the second Red Fox in program history to be named a Second Team AP All-American, following Terrence Fede, and it marked the second straight year that a Red Fox earned AP All-American honors. Hulstein led the FCS in receiving yards by a tight end, and he broke the program's tight end records for receiving touchdowns, receiving yards, and yards per reception. He was invited to attend minicamp with the New York Jets. Robinson was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award, while Hatton was a finalist for the Jerry Rice Award. Hatton was named PFL Defensive Freshman of the year, marking the second straight year this award was won by a Red Fox. Hulstein and Perricone both competed in the College Gridiron Showcase.

In Willis' first season, Jackson Conners-McCarthy was named an Honorable Mention FCS All-American by The Associated Press. Conners-McCarthy was one of three Marist FCS Freshman All-Americans, as he was joined by James Kratochvil and Nate Robinson Jr. This total was the highest in program history. Kratochvil was named PFL Defensive Rookie of the Year. The Red Foxes has one First Team All-PFL selection (Dominic Perricone) and two Second Team All-PFL selections (Conners-McCarthy, Tristan Shannon). Additionally, he aided in the development of Sonny Mannino, who started the year in a reserve role and ended with an Honorable Mention All-PFL selection at the all-purpose position after tying the single-game school records for passing touchdowns and rushing touchdowns. Mohamed Diawara and Miles Kauderer, who both served as team captains, were selected to play in the Dream Bowl.

Willis' tenure has also featured tremendous growth in the classroom. Marist has set program records for GPA, PFL Honor Roll recipients, PFL All-Academic honorees, NFF Hampshire Society honorees, CSC Academic All-District selections, and APR.

In the 2025-26 school year, Chris Leonardo became the first player in program history to be a finalist for the FCS ADA Postgraduate Scholarship and a national finalist for the Doris Robinson Award. Marist set a program record with eight College Sports Communicators Academic All-District selections, and it tied a record with nine PFL All-Academic team honorees. A total of 78 Red Foxes were named to the Pioneer Football League Academic Honor Roll.

In 2024-25, a program-record 83 Red Foxes were named to the Pioneer Football League Academic Honor Roll. Chris Leonardo was named to the FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team. Both Leonardo and Gannon McCorkle were First Team PFL All-Academic Team selections, while Tristan Shannon was named to the Second Team. Six Red Foxes (Leonardo, McCorkle, Sean Coverdale, David LaFears, Brandon Furey, Kade Werner) were named CSC Academic All-District. The team's Spring 2025 semester GPA of 3.405 was its best in program history.

Additionally, Willis was instrumental in the formation of the Marist Touchdown Club, Marist's first formal football alumni association. In 2025, the program broke its single-day fundraising record, which was then exceeded in 2026.

Willis came to Marist after having served as Assistant Head Coach/Offensive Coordinator at his alma mater, Princeton University. He spent nine years on the Tigers' staff after a playing career at Princeton that spanned from 2010-13. Between his time as a player and coach, Willis has been part of four Ivy League championships. His tenure at Princeton has been characterized by outstanding team and individual achievements. The Tigers posted a 40-10 record in Willis' last 50 games on staff.

Willis was Princeton's offensive coordinator for the past three seasons. During that time, the Tigers went 22-8 overall with a 15-6 record in Ivy League play while Willis coached 23 All-Ivy League players. In 2021, Princeton won the Ivy League championship, went 9-1 overall, set a program record with 10 First Team Ivy League selections, and led the Ancient Eight in scoring at 33.4 points per game. The following year, Princeton went 8-2 and was in Ivy League title contention until the season's final week. The Tigers led the Ivy League in scoring offense and ranked second in passing offense in 2022.

Willis was part of current Princeton head coach Bob Surace's first recruiting class for the 2010 season. In Willis' time as a student-athlete at Princeton, the program engineered a dramatic and lasting turnaround, going from a 1-9 record his freshman year to an Ivy League championship his senior year in 2013. In the 2013 season, Princeton set the Ivy League record for total offense. Beginning with the 2013 season, Princeton has won four league championships – with Willis having a hand in all of them – and has finished .500 or better every year since. Willis majored in Sociology at Princeton.

Willis and his wife, Maggie, are the parents of their four-year-old son, Campbell, and one-year-old daughter, Michaela.

History

- Marist is 3-2 all-time against Presbyterian, with a 1-1 mark at Tenney Stadium.

- Marist won the first three meetings, and Presbyterian won the last two.

National Leaderboard

- Marist has blocked a kick in each of its first three games this season, with blocked punts at New Haven (**Dylan Gilmore**) and Lafayette (**Jayden Taylor**), and a blocked PAT against Franklin Pierce (**Braylen Ricks**).

- Through Sept. 19, Marist is tied for third in the FCS in total blocked kicks, trailing only Valparaiso and Weber State, and is second in the FCS in blocked punts, trailing only Valparaiso.

- **Tyrell Powell** is third in the FCS with 2.0 passes defended per game (six break-ups in three games).

- **Kade Werner** leads the PFL and is 14th in the FCS in solo tackles per game (5.67).

- Marist is ranked 10th in the FCS in Red Zone Defense, allowed the opposition to score on 61.5% (8 of 13) trips inside the 20. Marist has allowed just one touchdown in these opportunities in addition to seven field goals.

Close Calls

- Marist's three games this season have been decided by a total of 14 points, with all three being single digits.

- Last season, four of Marist's eight PFL games were one-score contests.

Broken Up

- Marist's 10 pass break-ups at Lafayette were its most since having 10 against Jacksonville on Sept. 26, 2015.

- **Chase Hatton** and **Tyrell Powell** each had a career-high three break-ups.

Marist's PFL History

- Marist is 62-66 all-time in PFL play, having joined the league in 2009. Marist is 9-14 in September, 33-27 in October, 20-24 in November, and 0-1 in December.

- Marist is 31-34 at home, and 31-32 on the road in PFL play.

- Marist won a share of the PFL championship in 2013.

- QB **Sonny Mannino** was named PFL Preseason Offensive Player of the Year by Phil Steele Publications. Mannino, DB **Chase Hatton**, and LB **Nate Furrow** earned First Team honors. By Position

Quarterback: Sonny Mannino (12) has started 21 career games. He led the PFL in passing yards per game in league contests last year (201.9). Mannino has accounted for 41 total touchdowns since the start of the 2024 season (27 passing, 14 rushing). He has led the team in rushing touchdowns each of the previous two years, and he has a team-high three this season. In 2024, he tied Marist's single-game program records for passing touchdowns (5) and rushing touchdowns (4) in separate contests. He had a streak of 154 consecutive passes without an interception that was broken against Franklin Pierce, but he set a career high with 110 rushing yards in that contest. At Lafayette, he set a career high with 26 completions. Mannino has accounted for 79 percent of Marist's total offense this year, with a team-high 147 rushing yards to go along with 564 through the air. ... **Will O'Dell (18)** made two starts and appeared in nine games as a freshman last year.

Running Back: Lincoln Cardillo (4) has played in 18 career games, including all 11 in 2024. He ran for 45 yards on a career-high 11 carries vs. Franklin Pierce, and he leads the Red Foxes with 28 rushing attempts this season. ... **Jeremy DeCaro (26)** played in all 12 games last season, with seven starts, and accounted for 394 all-purpose yards. He led the Red Foxes with 44 rushing yards at New Haven, and had the team's longest run (29 yards), ... **Isaiah Simmons (2)** had nine carries for 32 yards and three catches for 30 yards vs. Franklin Pierce, and he had a team-best 28 rushing yards at Lafayette. Simmons played the last three seasons at Brockport, where he scored 50 touchdowns and ran for 3,697 yards.

Wide Receiver: Jayden Taylor (14) leads Marist in receiving yards (141) and is tied for the team lead in receptions (10). Taylor caught seven passes for 90 yards at Lafayette, which were both career highs and the highest totals for a Red Fox this season. Taylor had a 40-yard reception at New Haven, which was Marist's longest play from scrimmage in the game. ... **Reed Shumpert (15)** is in his second year at Marist after playing two years apiece at Washington State and Cal Poly. He was second on the team with 34 receptions last year, and has three this year. He has seven catches for 90 yards this season. ... **Reece Beauchamp (11)** is a transfer from Texas who missed last season due to injury. He had a 29-yard reception at Lafayette. ... **Chris Gioia (81)** had his first career reception at Lafayette. ... **Lance Martinez (7)** led Marist in receiving yards (580) & yards per catch (20.0) in 2025. He had 106 yards and two touchdowns vs. San Diego, and had seven games with at least 50 receiving yards.

H: Zach Garmont (5) had a team-high 64 receiving yards vs. Franklin Pierce, including Marist's longest play of the season (54 yards). Garmont had four receptions for 48 yards and a touchdown at Lafayette. played the past two seasons at Monmouth. He ... **Jason Thompson (13)** played at Stanford from 2022-25 and appeared in 17 games. He was named to the Pac-12 Academic Honor Roll in 2023. ... **Santino Correa (3)** caught a touchdown pass at Penn last year, and he has two receptions for 21 yards this season.

Tight End: Marco Lainez III (10) had four catches for 46 yards and a touchdown vs. Franklin Pierce. He is tied for the team lead with 10 receptions. Lainez played quarterback at Iowa (2023-24) and Elon (2025). ... **Joey Bemis (87)** has appeared in 14 career games.

Offensive Line: The Red Foxes have started the same quintet in all three games this season: LT **Aiden White (57)**, LG **Will Aaronson (63)**, C **Brandon Furey (66)**, RG **Hudson Dalton (56)**, and RT **Sal LoGrasso (75)**. ... Aaronson and Furey return as starters from last season. LoGrasso is in first year in the program after transferring from Lamar. White and Dalton are both in their second year in the program. ... **Samuel Morales (78)** has played in 14 games the last two seasons, and started at left tackle at Butler last season. ... **Giancarlo Scirocco (68)** has played in 11 career games and has rotated in at center. ... **TJ Surace (67)** is in his fourth year in the program, and has seen considerable action on PAT/field goal in addition to being an interior reserve. ... **Carson DeRoner (72)** has seen action in all three games this season.

Ricks leads the Red Foxes with three TFLs, with two coming at New Haven. ... Caldwell returned an interception 25 yards for a touchdown at New Haven. ... Coverdale had a sack vs. Franklin Pierce. ... **Naheem Ridore (5)** had two TFLs and a sack vs. Franklin Pierce. Ridore had a sack in each of his final three games of last season.

Linebacker: Kade Werner (29) leads the team with 23 tackles (17 solo), and he is second with 2.5 TFLs. He had a team-best 11 tackles and had 2 TFLs at New Haven. His 14 against San Diego last year were a career high and the most by a Red Fox in a game. ... **Nate Furrow (54)** has seven tackles and one TFL this season. He led Marist in tackles for loss (12), sacks (6), and forced fumbles (2) last year. He had five straight games with a TFL (total of 10 in that span) and three straight games with a sack (total of five in that span). Against San Diego, Furrow had 5 TFLs (most by a Red Fox since 2013) and 3 sacks (most by a Red Fox since 2015). ... **James Kratochvil (59)** has five tackles and one PBU this season. Dickinson College transfer **Chris Barnes (18)** had three tackles and a PBU at Lafayette. ... **Miles Harding (6)**, who played at Mount St. Joseph, and **Niles Riding (19)**, who previously played at Amherst, are graduate transfers.

Specialist: Ethan Yuska (45) is in his third season as Marist's punter. His average of 40.5 yards per punt last year was Marist's second-best in its FCS history. He averaged 44.7 yards on seven punts at New Haven, with a long of 58. ... **K Luke Stenson (46)** is 6-for-8 on PATs and 1-for-1 on field goal attempts this year. He is averaging 61.1 yards on 12 kickoffs. ... **Aidan McElderry (35)** and **Bode Ganny (49)** are splitting long-snapping duties. ... **Jason Thompson (13)** had 21 kickoff returns in his four years at Stanford, and had three at New Haven. ... **Jeremy DeCaro (26)** was named PFL Special Teams Player of the Week after amassing 87 yards on seven punt returns vs. San Diego in 2025. ...
