### GAME DAY

The Colgate Raiders (2-2, PL 0-1) will be looking to get back on the winning track Saturday, when they play host to Bucknell (2-3, PL 0-0) in a Patriot League game on Homecoming Weekend.

Last Saturday, Colgate opened its Patriot League schedule and saw Fordham rally for a 34-31 win after trailing 24-13 at halftime. Bucknell, meanwhile, was closing out its non-league schedule with a 38-7 victory over Marist.

Junior tailback **Jordan Scott** (Hyattsville, MD) is averaging 167.0 yards per game for the Raiders. He leads the Patriot League in rushing and is fourth in the FCS. Scott has six straight games over 100 yards rushing. Last Saturday, he carried 40 times for 174 yards and two touchdowns against the Rams.

Junior quarterback **Alex Relph** (Victor, NY), who is leading the Patriot League in passing efficiency with a 129.07 rating, has completed 54-of-91 passes for 678 yards and five touchdowns.

Senior wide receiver **Erik Burke** (Traverse City, Mich.) leads the receiving corp with 22 catches for 332 yards and four touchdowns. He is currently 12th in career receiving yardage with 1,323 yards. Burke is second in the league in receiving yardage per game (83.0) and 29th in the FCS. Sophomore **Pat Simonds** (Sidney, N.Y.) has 13 catches for 199 yards and one touchdown.

Defensively, senior All-America linebacker **Mike Gallihugh** (Midlothian, VA) is second in the FCS in tackling with 12.75 per game. He has 51 tackles, including 3 TFL's, 1.5 quarterback sacks and one interception. Senior defensive end **Ryan Keller** (Colts Neck, NJ) has 25 tackles and sophomore safety **Uzi Idah** (Rolling Hills Estate, CA) has 22.

On special teams, senior punter **Jacob Stein** (St. Petersburg, FL) is averaging 36.8 yards per punt, while senior cornerback **Cody Williams** (Blasdell, NY) is eighth in the FCS and first in the PL with 33.0 yards per kickoff return. Senior placekicker **Mike Buck** (Basking Ridge, NJ) is 9-for-9 on PAT's and 5-of-7 on field goals including one game winner.

## THE SERIES

This is the 56th meeting between Colgate and Bucknell with the Raiders leading the overall series 39-16. However, the Bison had taken two of the last three outings, including a 31-28 decision last year in Lewisburg.

The Raiders have won three straight here at Andy Kerr Stadium, where the Bison are 7-23.

## COLGATE TRI-CAPTAINS

Senior linebacker **Mike Gallihugh** (Midlothian, VA), senior defensive tackle **Pat Nolan** (Exeter, NH) and senior defensive back **Cody Williams** (Blasdell, NY) have been named tri-captains for the 2007 season.

## COLGATE HEAD COACH

Colgate head coach **Dick Biddle** is in his 12th season with the Raiders. He has an overall record of 90-44 for a .671 winning percentage. In 2003, he was named the American Football Coaches Association Division I-AA National Coach of the Year, and three times in his career he has been Patriot League Coach of the Year.

His Patriot League and overall winning percentage is the highest of any coach who has coached eight or more seasons in the league. He is the second winningest coach in school history.

Biddle is the first Colgate coach to post 10 straight winning seasons and the first Colgate coach to record nine straight seasons with seven or more victories.

## BIDDLE MOVING UP THE LADDER

**Dick Biddle** needs six victories to become the winningest coach in Colgate history. He already owns the Patriot League records for wins in league games (53) and overall victories (90). Now he's set to pass former Lafayette head coach Bill Russo in Patriot League games coached. Biddle enters the season with 67 games coached in the league, which means he's in position to tie Russo's mark of 70 when the Raiders visit Lafayette on Oct. 27.

## GALLIHUGH ON BUCHANAN WATCH LIST

Colgate linebacker **Mike Gallihugh** (Midlothian, Va.), the Patriot League Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, has been selected to the Buck Buchanan Award watch list for the second year in a row. The Buck Buchanan Award goes to the most outstanding defensive player in the Football Championship Subdivision.

## TOUGH AGAINST THE RUSH

Over the last 12 seasons, the Raiders have held the opposition to less than 100 yards rushing 55 times, and are 52-3 when doing so.

## STINGY ON THE GROUND

Colgate's defense has allowed only three rushing touchdowns in the first four games.

## RAIDER NOTEBOOK

Junior tailback **Jordan Scott** (Hyattsville, MD) has a streak of six straight games over 100 yards - Holy Cross (154), Bucknell (184), Albany (180), UMass (103), Dartmouth (211) and Fordham (174). He has 17 career games with 100 yards or more - good for third place all-time ... He is tied for third in 200-yard games, one behind Jamaal Branch (2000-01, 03-04).

## GALLIHUGH IS THE PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Senior linebacker **Mike Gallihugh** (Midlothian, VA) was selected as the Patriot League preseason Defensive Player of the Year in a vote of the league coaches and sports information directors. Last year, he was a finalist for the Buck Buchanan Award, given to the top defensive player in the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (formerly I-AA).

Gallihugh led the FCS in tackling last fall with 12.73 tackles per game. He finished with 140 tackles in 11 games.

## TWO COLGATE PLAYERS TABBED WITH PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Senior linebacker **Mike Gallihugh** (Midlothian, VA) has been tabbed first team All-America by The Sports Network, *Street & Smith* and *Lindy's* Football Magazines and second team by the College Sporting News.

Junior tailback **Jordan Scott** (Hyattsville, MD) was a third team All-America selection by The Sports Network.

## BREAKS TWO-YEAR RECORD

**Jordan Scott** rushed for 2,598 yards in his first two seasons breaking Kenny Gamble's (1984-85) record for most career rushing yardage by a sophomore running back. Gamble had 1,993 yards.

## BACK-TO-BACK 1,000-YARD SEASONS

**Jordan Scott** is the third player in school history to post back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons. He joins former Colgate All-American and Walter Payton Award winners - Kenny Gamble (1985, 1986 and 1987) and Jamaal Branch (2003 and 2004).
