OPENING TIP-OFF

- The University of Minnesota (10-17, 3-13 B1G) wraps up its road schedule with a matchup with the Spartans of Michigan State on Wednesday night in East Lansing, Mich. The game at the Bresline Center will tip at 6 p.m. CT on B1G+ and can be heard on the iHeartRadio app or on KFAN+ with Justin Gaard and Lynnette Sjoquist on the call.
- Minnesota's matchup with Michigan State is the 71st meeting between the two programs. Last year the two teams split their season matchups with both teams winning at home. The Gophers have not won in East Lansing since 2009 when the Gophers won 66-51.
- Last time out the Maroon and Gold fell to the Wildcats of Northwestern on the road, dropping to 1-9 on the road this season. The Gophers, who committed 25 turnovers in the loss, lost 76-62 in Evanston with Mara Braun (12) and Katie Borowicz (11) leading the way offensively.

- For just the second time this season the Gophers bench scored 27 or more points in two consecutive games in the loss against Northwestern. Minnesota's 27 bench points against the Wildcats came from Borowicz (11), Hammond (6), Oberg (4), Gradwell (3) and Cayton (3). The 27 points from the bench came on the heels of the reserves scoring a Big Ten season high 37 against Nebraska. Minnesota's longest streak of 27 or more bench points this season is three (vs. Lehigh, at NDSU and vs. Presbyterian). Minnesota's 37 bench points against Nebraska were the most against a Big Ten opponent since the team had 41 against Maryland on March 3, 2017.
- Freshman Mara Braun has returned as a consistent scorer for the Gophers, scoring in double figures in eight of her last nine games. Braun has connected on at least one three in nine straight games and has shot 45.7 percent (16-of-35) from beyond the arc in her last six games while averaging 16.4 points per game.
- For the first time since Feb. 22, 2019, the Gophers had a points-assists double double when freshman Amaya Battle finished with 10 and 10 against Wisconsin (2/11). In the same game Battle passed Joan Kowalsky (1977-78) for the most assists in a single season by a freshman in program history. The 45-year old record goes down with Battle at 118 assists with still two regular season games to go.
- Through 27 games Minnesota has proved to be the best all-around rebounding team in the Big Ten conference. The Gophers are No. 1 in rebounding in both conference games (41.1 per game) and overall this season (42.3 per game). The team is also No. 2 in the Big Ten in offensive rebounds per game overall this season at 13.6 and is No. 1 during conference play at 13.0 per game.

GOPHERS QUICK HITTERS

- According to Minnesota's Strength and Conditioning Coach, Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux is the strongest player in the weight room that head coach Lindsay Whalen has had in her tenure at Minnesota benching 165 pounds.
- There are 23 student-athletes on 2022-23 Big Ten rosters that are from Minnesota... just under 12 percent of all Big Ten student-athletes that are Minnesota natives.
- Freshman guard Mara Braun is a student-athlete ambassador with Special Olympics Minnesota.
- Freshman forward Niamya Holloway helpe co-found the Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School in Minnesota and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- When coming out of high school in California Mi'Cole Cayton was recruited by Shimmy Gray-Miller. Cayton credits that relationship back in 2014/2015 to why she decided to join the Gophers as a graduate transfer this season.
- Freshman Maria Counts has four siblings, all who play or played basketball at Providence Academy. Maria played with her sisters Grace and Hope last year during her senior year and her elder sisters Clara and Anna played for Providence Academy baack in 2016 and 2018.
- Angelina Hammond graduated from Hopkins high school in 2018, playing alongside then-sophomore Paige Bueckers, then-eighth-grader Amaya Battle and then-eighth-grader Maya Nnaji.
- Mallory Heyer was an outstanding volleyball player at Chaska high school, emassing over 1,000 kills in her career and led her volleyball team to a 2AAAA Section runner-up finish in 2019.
- Niaymya Holloway was a two-time high school high jump state champion at Eden Prairie high school where she cleared a personal record 5-10. Her senior year she won a state championship in the high jump, took third in both the 4x200m relay and the 4x400m relay and was ninth in the shot put competition. Two days after the state championship track meet, she was at summer workouts with the Gophers.
- Alexa Ratzlaff's brother Jake used to play for the Wisconsin Badgers football team as an inside linebacker. Her brother was the 2020 Metro Football Player of the Year by the Minneapolis Star Tribune and was a finalist for Minnesota's Mr. Football Award. He also committed to the Gophers men's hockey program early in his career before focusing and shifting to football.
- Freshman guard Mara Braun is the first graduate from Wayzata high school to play for the Golden Gophers.
- Katie Borowicz: Joined Gophers as early enrollee in 2019-20; graduated early from high school after signing NLI in November of 2020
- Maggie Czinano: Her sister Monika, is currently a senior on the lowa women's basketball team and is a multiple time All-Big Ten selection
- Alanna Micheaux: Changed her number from No. 54 to No. 4 in honor of her brother.
- Kelly Curry: Was a freshman on the 2004 Final Four team, which was Lindsay Whalen's senior season; was previously an assistant at North Dakota State (2008-10) and Minnesota (2010-14) and most recently served as head coach at Macalaster College in Saint Paul (2014-18).

- Minnesota's freshman class has been heralded as one of the most highly touted recruiting classes in program history. All four hail from the great state of Minnesota with Mara Braun (Wayzata, Minn.), Amaya Battle (Hopkins, Minn.), Mallory Heyer (Chaska, Minn.) and Niamya Holloway (Eden Prairie, Minn.).
- The Maroon and Gold's 11 newcomers are broken up by five transfers, four incoming freshmen and two walk-ons. Minnesota's transfers include Destinee Oberg (Arkansas), Mi'Cole Cayton (Nebraska), Isabelle Gradwell (Cleveland State), Angelina Hammond (Miami Dade) and Aminata Zie (Western Nebraska CC).

FACING MICHIGAN STATE

- Minnesota is 24-46 overall against the Spartans.
- The Gophers last win in East Lansing was on Feb. 26, 2009. Since then the Gophers are 0-9 against Michigan State on the road.
- The Spartans are coming off a 66-61 loss to Maryland at home on Feb. 18. Prior to that the squad had won two in a row over Wisconsin and Penn State.
- The Spartans are 4-11 against common opponents this season with the Gophers.
- Michigan State was not selected in either of the Big Ten's preseason polls.
- Offensively the Spartans are led by Kamaria McDaniel, a transfer, at 13.7 points per game. She hits 34 percent of her shots from beyond the arc and is second on the team in assists (66) and is third on the team in blocks (12).
- As a team the Spartans are No. 1 in the Big Ten in free throw attempts per game (21.2), offensive rebounds per game (13.8) and are No. 2 in turnovers forced per game (21.0), turnover margin (+6.2) and threes attempted per game (24.8).

CLUTCH-TIME STATS FOR THE GOPHERS

- In games decided by six points or less the Gophers have shot 40.6 percent (13-of-32) in the final two minutes of regulation and 70.30 percent (19-of-27) from the free throw line.

- In the last two minutes of regulation (not including OT/20T) the Gophers have shot 40.0 percent (32-of-80) from the floor and 75.4 percent (46-of-61) from the free throw line.
- In fourth quarters this season the Gophers have shot 42.1 percent (179-of-425) and have shot 72.6 percent (122-of-168) from the free throw line.

THE BABY GOPHS

- As of Feb. 21, Amaya Battle is the No. 2 rebounding freshman in the Big Ten this season at 5.9 per game, and is also the No. 1 freshman in assists per game at 4.4. Overall Battle is 16th in rebounds in the Big Ten and is seventh in assists.
- Mallory Heyer is the No. 1 rebounding freshman in the Big Ten this season at 7.2 per game, and is also the No. 1 freshman in offensive rebounds per game at 2.2 per game. Overall Heyer is eighth in the Big Ten in total rebounds per game and is eighth in offensive rebounds per game.
- So far this season 1178 of the Gophers 1931 points (61.0 percent) have been scored by true or redshirt freshman. Four of the top five scorers this season for the Gophers are all freshmen or redshirt freshmen. In total the Gophers freshmen average 46.1 points per game combined.
- The University of Minnesota women's basketball team brings in a total of seven freshmen to the 2022-23 roster (redshirts included). That is the second most freshmen on any Big Ten roster, only behind Wisconsin's nine.
- The Gophers top three players in average minutes are the trio of true freshman with Braun leading the way at 32.8 followed by Heyer at 32.0 and Battle at 29.0. In the Big Ten Braun has played the 14th-most minutes per game.

The 2023 tournament marks the 39th edition of the continental showpiece event, and will see 16 teams fight for the coveted title. The event will be co-hosted by Slovenia and Israel.

- Lindsay Whalen announced on Jan. 6, the signing of center Sophie Hart to the Gophers' program. Hart is a 6-5 graduate of Farmington High School, who played two seasons at NC State, and will join Minnesota with two years of eligibility.
- Hart will be eligible to play for the Gophers in the 2023-24 season after she played five games earlier this season with the Wolfpack. Hart will be able to practice with the Golden Gophers for the remainder of the 2022-23 season.
- Coming out of high school Hart was the No. 64 ranked overall recruit in the class of 2021 and the No. 5 ranked player at her position by ESPN.

WOMEN'S HOOPS SIGN FIVE FOR 2023-24

- Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen has announced the addition of five student-athletes that have signed National Letters of Intent or an Acceptance of Admission to join the Minnesota women's basketball program for the 2023-24 season. Signing NLIs with the Golden Gophers are Kennedy Klick, MyKynnlie Dalan, Ajok Madol and Dominika Paurová while Brynn Senden signed an Acceptance of Admission.
- "I am thrilled to announce this incoming recruiting class that includes five outstanding young women who come from all over the world and embody exactly what it means to be a Gopher," Whalen said. "This group has a wide range of skills that we are extremely excited about. They are not only outstanding basketball players, but are also outstanding people."

GOPHER TO HOST UCONN IN 2023-24 AT WILLIAMS ARENA

- The University of Minnesota women's basketball program has added UConn to its upcoming schedule with a game to be played at Williams Arena in 2023.
- The Gophers will host the Huskies on Nov. 19, 2023, with the meeting being the first between the two programs in the state of Minnesota. UConn holds an all-time record of 3-0 against the Maroon and Gold. Minnesota is 24-13 against current teams in the BIG EAST.

GOPHER SEASON SYNOPSIS

GRADWELL'S DAGGER THREE TAKES OUT HUSKERS AT THE BARN

- In a thrilling finish, Isabelle Gradwell hit a corner three with 1.1 sseconds left to take down Nebraska at Williams Arena. Led by 28 points from Mara Braun, who dished the game-winning basket, the Gophers won their second Big Ten game at home this season.
- Minnesota's win over Nebraska was the team's best win in regards to the NET rankings with Nebraska entering at No. 44. Minnesota also overcame being called for 31 personal fouls, the most under head coach Lindsay Whalen. Despite that, the Gophers persevered and won the game which marked the only time since at least 2009 that any Big Ten team has defeated another Big Ten team when committing 31 or more fouls (according to HerHoopStats.com).

WISCONSIN SWEEPS GOPHERS WITH OT VICTORY

- Despite a career night from freshman forward Mallory Heyer (28 points, 15 rebounds) the Golden Gophers fell to the Wisconsin Badgers 76-70 in OT.
- Fellow freshman Amaya Battle secured her first points-assists double double of her career with 10 points and 10 assists.

OHIO STATE HANDLES MINNESOTA IN COLUMBUS

- Ohio State scored 23 or more in the first three quarters on their way to a 93-63 victory over Minnesota on Feb. 8, in Columbus.
- Mara Braun scored a team-high 19 points while Amaya Battle added eight points and five assists and five boards.

RV/24 ILLINOIS HOLDS OFF GOPHERS COMEBACK

- The Golden Gophers dropped a road tilt with the Fighting Illini by a score of 69-62. With the game tied at 60 with 1:51 to go, Illinois scored nine of the final 11 points in the contest to hold off the Gophers 10-point fourth quarter comeback.
- Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux scored a game-high 24 points and added 11 boards for her ninth double double of the season with Mara Braun adding 11 pts.

ILLINOIS RACES PAST GOPHERS IN MINNEAPOLIS

- The Gophers were defeated by No. 24/24 Illinois 70-57 at Williams Arena on Jan. 15. Sophomore Rose Micheaux secured her sixth double double of the season in the loss with 24 points and 14 rebounds.
- Freshman Amaya Battle scored 11 points and added seven rebounds, six assists and a pair of steals. Maggie Czinano made her first career start for the Maroon and Gold, the sophomore shot 3-of-4 from the floor and had six points and five rebounds.

RUTGERS HOLDS OFF MINNESOTA AT THE BARN

- The Gophers dropped a 65-59 contest to Rutgers at Williams Arena on Jan. 12. Freshman Mallory Heyer scored 18 points while sophomore Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux secured her fifth double double of the season with 17 points and 10 rebounds in the loss.
- Heyer's 18 points came on 7-of-11 shooting from the floor with the freshman adding seven boards and three assists in 32 minutes. Micheaux's double double was on 7-of-13 from the floor and her 10 rebounds included eight on the offensive end.

GOPHERS EXPLODE FOR 105 IN WIN OVER CHICAGO ST.

- The 105 points were the most under head coach Lindsay Whalen. Minnesota's 64 total rebounds is tied for the fifth-most in school history.

- Announced on Sunday on ESPN, Minnesota's Lindsay Whalen has been named as an inductee for the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Whalen is joined by Carolyn Peck, Cathy Boswell, Donna Lopiano and Lisa Mattingly.
- The induction will be April 29, 2023, at the Historic Tennessee Tehatre in Knoxville, Tennessee.

WHALEN INDUCTED TO BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

- Minnesota's Lindsay Whalen officially was enshrined in the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame on September 10, 2022, in Springfield Mass.
- Whalen (Hutchinson, Minn.) was a first ballot Hall of Famer, and was a part of a class that saw Leta Andrews, Swin Cash, Michael Cooper, Hugh Evans, Manu Ginóbili, Tim Hardaway, Bob Huggins, Marques Johnson, George Karl and Marianne Stanley all get enshrined.
- Whalen's Hall of Fame presenters were Charles Barkley and Dawn Staley.
- Whalen was the first Gopher women's basketball player, and the seventh player overall, to be enshrined in the Hall of Fame joining the likes of Kevin McHale who was inducted in 1999 and "Sweet Lou" Hudson.

THE INCREDIBLE 2022 FRESHMEN CLASS

- The class was the No. 1 ranked recruiting class in the Big Ten (No. 10 nationally) ahead of lowa who's class was ranked No. 20 nationally by ESPN/Premier Basketball and Michigan at No. 22.
- Amaya Battle (Hopkins, Minn.) won Minnesota's Ms. Basketball as a senior out of Hopkins High School. Battle helped her team win a state championship on the floor of Williams Arena. Battle also won a state championship with Hopkins in 2019.
- Mara Braun and Niamya Holloway are both outstanding off the court as well with Braun a Student-Athlete ambassador for the Special Olympics in Minnesota and Holloway was a co-founder of her high school's Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- Braun (Track and Field), Heyer (Volleyball) and Holloway (Track and Field) all were multi-sport athletes at the prep level.
- Holloway was a two-time Minnesota high school state champion with a personal best leap of 5-11 during her senior season.
- Mallory Heyer had over 1,000 kills as a volleyball player at Chaska High School where her team made multiple section finals.
- On top of the Gophers four ranked prospects, the Gophers added two walk on freshmen, all six hail from the great state of Minnesota.

THE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT IS COMING TO MINNEAPOLIS

- On April 20, 2022, the Big Ten announced that the Big Ten basketball tournaments in 2023 and 2024 were coming to Minneapolis and the Target Center.
- Target Center will host the 2023 women's tourney and the men's and women's tourney in 2024.
- The 2022 Women's Final Four, which was held in Target Center, set an attendance record with over 216,000 spectators during the event. That was the most at the Women's Final Four since 2004... which was when the Golden Gophers led by Lindsay Whalen made their first Final Four in New Orleans.

THE INCREDIBLE RETURN OF KATIE BOROWICZ

- After missing the entire 2021-22 season with a seaosn-ending skull/spinal surgery, the Gophers welcome back guard Katie Borowicz (Roseau, Minn.).
- On Monday, Nov. 7, Borowicz played her first game at Williams Arena in over 600 days (Feb. 28, 2021 vs. Michigan).
- In her return to the court Borowicz scored a careerhigh 16 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the floor including a career-high four made threes in 22 minutes.
- Borowicz had not played in front of fans since high school (March 4, 2020 vs. Fergus Falls in the Minnesota State Tournament).
- Borowicz missed last season after having surgery to relieve pressure that her brain was putting on her spine. Her condition is called Chiari malformation.

THE GOPHERS AND THE TRANSFER PORTAL

• In total the Maroon and Gold bring in five transfers to the 2022-23 roster. Joining Minnesota this season are Mi'Cole Cayton (Nebraska/Cal), Destinee Oberg (Arkansas), Isabelle Gradwell (Cleveland State), Angelina Hammond (Siena/Southeastern/Miami Dade) and Aminata Zie (Western Nebraska CC/Stony Brook).

ZIE AND HOLLOWAY TO MISS ALL OF 2022-23 SEASON

- Prior to the start of the 2022-23 season the Gophers have sustained a pair of season-ending injuries from a pair of post players in Niamya Holloway (knee) and Aminata Zie (leg).
- Zie suffered her injury in late October while Holloway's injury was suffered in July. Both student-athletes have completed successful surgery and are currently in rehab.

WEEKLY AWARDS DATED BY MOST RECENT DURING THE 2022-23 SEASON

BIG TEN HONOR ROLL:

Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux (Jan. 23)

- The Wayne, Mich., native posted back-to-back career highs in rebounds for the Gophers, highlighted by a 31-point 14-rebound double double in a road win over Penn State. Micheaux averaged 16.5 points per game, 14.5 rebounds per game last week and averaged 4.5 offensive rebounds per game.
- Micheaux's 31-point performance at Penn State led the Maroon and Gold to their first road win of the season with the sophomore's 20 points in the first half being the second most in any half this season (Braun 22).

BIG TEN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK: Mara Braun (Dec. 5)

- The Wayzata, Minn., native set a new Minnesota record for points in a Big Ten debut with 26 in a comeback win over Penn State and in two games averaged 26.5 points per game, 3.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.5 rebounds while shooting 51.6 percent from the floor and hitting six threes.
- Braun hit 11-of-11 free throws against Penn State, becoming just one of 24th Gopher to connect on 10 or more free throws in a game and make them all (11-of-11). She led Minnesota to two secondhalf comebacks during the week, overcoming a 10-point deficit to defeat Penn State in double overtime and helping the Gophers tie the game with 19 seconds left against Wake Forest.

BIG TEN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK: Mallory Heyer (Nov. 21)

• The Chaska, Minn., native posted her first career double double with 19 points and 10 rebounds in a win over Presbyterian on Nov. 20, and averaged 14.5 points and 9.0 rebounds during the week while shooting 66.7 percent from the floor (14-of-21). She brought down an average of 4.5 offensive rebounds per game and added 2.0 assists and 1.0 block per game.

BIG TEN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK: Mara Braun (Nov. 14)

- Braun dropped an average of 27.5 points per game in her first two collegiate contests, including 34 and a buzzer-beating shot to take down Lehigh 101-99.
- Braun's buzzer beater with 1.7 seconds left was the first last-second winning shot for Minnesota since Feb. 26, 2016, when Carlie Wagner downed No. 5 Ohio State in overtime. Her 34 points are the second most points by a freshman in school history and are the most since Laura Coenen at Wisconsin back on Feb. 18, 1983.

GRAY-MILLER PROMOTED TO ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- On July 5, 2022, head coach Lindsay Whalen announced that Shimmy Gray-Miller had been promoted to the title of Associate Head Coach.
- Gray-Miller took over the position for the departed Carly Thibault-DuDonis who is now the head coach at Fairfield University.
- In her lone season at Minnesota, the Gophers reached the postseason and Gray-Miller coached Alanna Micheaux to a Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor after a big-time performance in B1G/ACC Challenge game against North Carolina. She also coached Bailey Helgren who was named the Gophers' honoree on the Big Ten All-Sportsmanship team. Gray-Miller directly impacted the Gophers statistical improvement in a number of categories from the 2020-21 season to the 2021-22 season including field goal percentage (.402 to .407), opponent field goal percentage (.453 to .426), rebounds per game (35.95 to 36.91) and blocks per game (2.5 to 3.5).

THE RETURN OF THE MAROON MAMBA

- The University of Minnesota welcomed back one of the most successful players in program history this offseason with Rachel Banham joining the Gophers' staff as the Director of Quality Control.
- As the Director of Quality Control Banham, who still
 is playing in the WNBA, will provide support to the staff
 to enhance the quality and efficiency of day-to-day operations, and is responsible for assisting with practice,
 game preparation, statistical analysis and more.
- Bannam rejoins the program where she shattered the record books during her playing time from 2011-16. She scored 3,093 points, leaving the college game as the No. 1 scorer in Big Ten history and sixth in NCAA history. She was the 2016 Big Ten Player of the Year and made 354 threes during her career, a program record. She is arguably most known for her then-NCAA record 60-point performance against Northwestern in 2016, a year that ended with her earning a First Team All-American nod.

NEW COACH, WHO DIS?

- On May 19, 2022, head coach Lindsay Whalen added Marwan Miller to the Gophers' coaching staff as an assistant coach.
- Miller is the Gophers' first Black male assistant coach since Marc Wilson from 1997-2001.
- In six seasons at Ohio, Miller and the Bobcats finished with a record of 121-64 including a 30-win season and a 26-win season during his tenue. The team also won the 2015-16 MAC regular season title with Miller on staff.
- Miller coached six All-MAC honorees, five Defensive Players of the Year, seven All-Defensive team members, four All-Freshmen, two top freshmen, and one Sixth Player of the Year.

MAINES PROMOTED TO 'FIRST OF ITS KIND' GENERAL MANAGER ROLE

- On August 2, 2022, head coach Lindsay Whalen announced that Director of Basketball Operations Melissa Maines had been promoted to the position of General Manager of Women's Basketball.
- In her new role, Maines will oversee all off-court aspects of the Minnesota women's basketball program. The role is the first of its kind in the Big Ten conference.

THE LINDSAY WHALEN COACHING TREE

- Entering just her fifth season as head coach, Lindsay Whalen has already aided numerous coaches in their pursuit to becoming head coaches at the DI level.
- Two of Whalen's former staff members are current head coaches including Carly Thibault-DuDonis (Fairfield University) and Danielle O'Banion, Loyola University Maryland). Thibault-DuDonis is entering her first year as a head coach while O'Banion is entering her second season as the head of her program.

HEAD COACH LINDSAY WHALEN FIFTH SEASON • MINNESOTA, 2004



One of the most decorated players in women's basketball history, Lindsay Whalen returned to her alma mater as the 12th head women's basketball coach at the University of Minnesota on April 13, 2018.

In her four seasons guiding the Golden Gophers, Whalen has led the team to a 60-57 mark (.518) with a trip to the WNIT in 2018-19 and 2021-22. In addition, she has coached one WNBA draft pick, one All-American, 11 All-Big Ten

honorees, two members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, one Big Ten All-Defensive Team player and countless Academic All-Big Ten honorees.

The 2021-22 season saw the Maroon and Gold make their way to the postseason for the second time in four seasons under Whalen with a bid to the WNIT where the squad reached the second round. The team matched its 7-11 Big Ten record from the previous season and finished 15-18 overall. Minnesota played one of the toughest schedules in the country, and the hardest in the Big Ten, playing a total of 10 NCAA Tournament teams, defeating one. The Gophers also partook in the first women's Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas, defeating Syracuse while also battling UConn and Oklahoma.

Sara Scalia was named Second Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches and media while first-year Gopher Deja Winters earned an Honorable Mention All-Big Ten nod by the members of the media.

The 2020-21 campaign, which took place amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, saw a young Gophers squad improve their conference win total from five to seven as they went 8-13 on the season and 7-11 in conference play. With 10 of its 13 players either freshmen or sophomores, no team in the Big Ten had a higher percentage of its roster comprised of underclassmen than Minnesota. In fact, of the 13 Gophers on the roster, six were playing in their first season of collegiate basketball and three transfers were playing in their first year at Minnesota.

Jasmine Powell was named Second Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches and Honorable Mention All-Big Ten by the media covering the conference. Meanwhile, Sara Scalia was chosen Honorable Mention All-Big Ten by the coaches and media.

In Whalen's second season the Gophers went 16-15, including winning 11 straight games at one point, which was the sixth longest win streak in program history. During the stretch, they won four straight on the road, the seventh longest such streak at Minnesota. Included in the 11-game streak was an 80-66 upset of then-No. 19 Arizona State.

Five members of the team took home season honors from the Big Ten. Taiye Bello was a consensus All-Big Ten Second Team selection by the league's coaches and media, while Powell was a consensus pick for both All-Big Ten Honorable Mention and the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. Gadiva Hubbard was an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honoree by the media, as was Scalia, who also earned a place on the media's Big Ten All-Freshman Team.



In her first season at the helm of the Gophers, Whalen guided the team to a 21-11 record overall, a 9-9 mark in league play and a spot in the second round of the WNIT. She became the fifth coach in program history to lead the team to 20 wins in their first season. The Gophers enjoyed a 10-week run in the AP Poll, their longest stretch since the 2005-06 season.

Minnesota began the 2018-19 season by winning its first 12 games, tied for the third best streak in team history.

With the 12-0 start, Whalen tied her former coach, Pam Borton (2002-03), for the best undefeated start by a coach in their first year at a Big Ten school since the incorporation of women's athletics in the conference in 1982-83. The only coach at a Big Ten school with more wins in his or her first year there was Ohio State's Debbie Wilson, who started 14-0 in 1972-73.

Under Whalen's tutelage, Kenisha Bell earned honorable mention All-America honors from the AP, was a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year Award, garnered consensus First Team All-Big Ten honors from the league's coaches and media and was a member of the All-Big Ten Defensive Team. In addition, Destiny Pitts was named First Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches (second team by the media), and Taiye Bello was an All-Big Ten honorable mention honore.

Whalen returned to the Gophers after destroying the program's record book in the early 2000s, finishing her career as Minnesota's all-time points leader, along with being second all-time in assists and third all-time in steals. A four-time all-state selection at Hutchinson High School, about an hour west of Minneapolis, Whalen went on to become the catalyst for the most successful seasons in the history of Gopher women's basketball.

In international competition, Whalen was a key piece to dominant performances by Team USA in world championship and Olympic competition. Whalen played for two gold medal teams at the World Championships (2010, 2014) and has also won two Olympic gold medals (2012, 2016).

As part of Whalen's agreement to become head coach, she continued to play for the Minnesota Lynx before retiring at the end of the 2018 season. Previously, Whalen announced in February of 2018 that she was retiring from international competition. She had played for the U.S. National team since 2002, joining Team USA following her sophomore season with the Gophers.
