# HEAD COACH BARBARA CROUSEN

10TH SEASON | 2007 WEST REGION  
MALE COACH OF THE YEAR



Success is beginning to be old hat for head coach Barbara Crousen and the McMurry University track program. Since taking over the program in the summer of 1998, Crousen has helped McMurry become a consistent track power in the south region among NCAA Division III schools.

Since her first season in 1999, Crousen led the men's team to nine consecutive American Southwest Conference titles (1999-2007) and the women's team to eight ASC championships in the last nine seasons (1999-2004, 2006-2007). During that time, she has been named the ASC's Men's Coach of the Year all nine seasons and seven times she was named the Women's ASC Coach of the Year.

Most recently, in 2007, she was named the men's South Region Coach of the Year for the second straight year marking fifth time she'd earned the honor. In 2006, the men's team finished fourth at the national outdoor meet in Lisle, Ill. and was the highest finish of any men's team in school history. In 2007, she coached the men's sprint relay team to a national title as Hann Ollison, Bert Green, John Mikalik and Chris Kelley won the first men's relay title in school history.

Crousen was named the women's South Region Coach of the Year three straight years (2000-2002) including the nation's highest honor in 2001 when she was named NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year. The women's program finished fourth overall at the national outdoor meet in 2001 and followed in 2002 as the national runner up.

92 all-America honors have been earned at McMurry since Crousen's tenure began in 1999, including 14 this past season in 2007. 18 have earned academic all-America honors and she's coached 21 national champions between indoor and outdoor competitions. She also coached the South Region Athlete of the Year 11 times including Hanneus Ollison most recently who won the honor for the second-straight season in 2007.

Darcell Edwards, who may be the most prolific female athlete to compete in McMurry's track and field program, won six individual national championships under Crousen. Edwards still holds the NCAA Division III outdoor record for the triple jump with a mark of 44 feet and two inches that she set in 2004. Edwards also qualified for the 2004 Olympic Trials in the triple jump.

Brad Parris, who is now Crousen's assistant, set the NCAA Division III record in the outdoor pole vault with a jump of 17 feet and nine inches in 2000. Parris' record fell in 2002.

A renowned clinician throughout the Lone Star state and well respected by her peers, Crousen is USA Track and Field Level I certified in the sport, certified in USA TF Level II for sprints and hurdles and a USATF Level I Lead Instructor. She has been published in the *Texas High School Coaches Association Magazine* and has produced four track-related videos detailing tips on coaching and improving athletes' performance. She has had five athletes attend the USA Junior Elite Olympics Training Camp in Colorado Springs, Colo., and San Diego, Calif.

Before coming to McMurry, Crousen worked in the Texas public school system for 32 years including a stint as Cooper High School's head track and cross country coach in Abilene.

In addition to her coaching duties, Crousen also serves McMurry as the assistant athletic director for compliance and is the senior woman's administrator for athletics. Her husband, Joe, was the head football coach at McMurry for the 2005 and 2006 seasons.

The couple has three children (Kevin, Kerri and Tamra), six grandchildren (Cooper, Claire, Carson, Foster, Stealey and Levi) and one terrier "Choco."



**ASST. COACH BRAD  
PARRIS**  
SEVENTH SEASON

Since 1999 when the McMurry track program joined the NCAA, Brad Parris has been making a positive impact on the school's track and field program. First, it was as a five-time national champion in the pole vault as

a student. Second, he was in a part-time role coaching McMurry's pole-vaulters while doubling as an elementary school teacher in the surrounding area. Now, Parris is the school's full-time track and field assistant and works to pass on his legacy to McMurry's athletes.

Parris won three straight pole vault championships in indoor competition from 1999-2001 and added two outdoor titles in 1999 and 2000. His junior year he set an NCAA Division III record for outdoor pole vault when he jumped 17 feet and six inches. His record was passed two years later but Parris' mark still stands at third all time at the division III level.

Throughout his collegiate career, he earned a plethora of honors for his performance in the pole vault. In 1999, he was named Outstanding Field Event Performer in Indoor Track for the South/Southeast Region of the NCAA. In 2000, he was the Outstanding Field Performer at the NCAA III Indoor Track and Field Meet as well as the American Southwest Conference Athlete of the Year. He holds the school record for both indoor and outdoor pole vaulting and has the meet record at McMurry's annual Indian Relays.

In 2001, his work in the classroom paid off as he was named a Verizon Academic All-American. He was a first team at-large selection, representing scholastic honors from all sports and all divisions of the NCAA. Parris' honor his senior season was just the tip of the iceberg. While at McMurry, he graduated with a 4.0 GPA, made the Dean's List 11 times, was a two-time academic all-Conference athlete and a three-time NCAA Division III Academic all-American.

After graduating from McMurry in 2001, he spent two years as a fourth grade teacher in Anson and a year as a fourth and fifth grade teacher in Merkel before becoming McMurry's full-time assistant in 2004.

Since joining the staff in 2001, Parris has coached six men and four women to individual ASC Championships in the pole vault and two women's high jumpers. He has also helped eight athletes reach national meets in the pole vault and three have reached national meets as high jumpers.

Parris married the former McMurry basketball standout Corissa Thompson and the couple has been married for three years. His mother, Dr. Pug Parris, is the chair of the physical education department at McMurry. His dad, Rickey, was a four-time NAIA pole vault champion for the Indians and was formerly on McMurry's track and field coaching staff.



**ASST. COACH DAVID  
CHANDLER**  
SIXTH SEASON

McMurry's head cross country coach David Chandler completed his seventh season as an assistant track coach to McMurry's distance runners in 2007.

Chandler has been on McMurry's coaching staff since 2001 as an assistant to both track and cross country. In 2003, he became the school's second head cross country coach in school history.

Chandler was a four-year letterman in cross country as a student at McMurry before graduating in 2000. He won the American Southwest Conference individual cross country championship in both 1998 and 2000 and helped the men's team to an ASC Championship in 2000. He was also a member of McMurry's first intercollegiate cross country team in 1996 founded by then-head-coach Bill Libby.

As a head coach, Chandler was named the ASC Men's Coach of the Year in 2004 and most recently, he was named the ASC Women's Coach of the Year after leading the McMurry women to their first ASC title in school history.

All in all, Chandler was an all-conference selection four times, an academic all-conference selection three times and was named to the NCAA all-region team his senior year. He placed 17th at the regional meet, which is the third best finish among McMurry men in school history. He also was a ASC track champion taking the 800-meter title in 1997 and was named all-conference twice in track and field.

Chandler has directed long distance camps and clinics since 1999 and has spoken on several occasions at coaches' clinics on distance running including the Texas HS Girls Coaching School, Corpus Christi Track Coaches Clinic and the Mississippi HS Track Coaches Association.

He is a member of both the USA Cross Country and Track and Field Coaches Associations and is USATF level I coach and has been a level II coach in endurance events since 2004.

Chandler graduated from McMurry with a B.S. in multidisciplinary studies with an emphasis in secondary history and physical education. He received his master's degree in sports recreation management from Hardin-Simmons in 2002. He also serves as a teacher in the physical education and servant leadership departments at McMurry.

Chandler, 28, married the former Janet Bohling in May 2002 and the couple resides in Abilene.



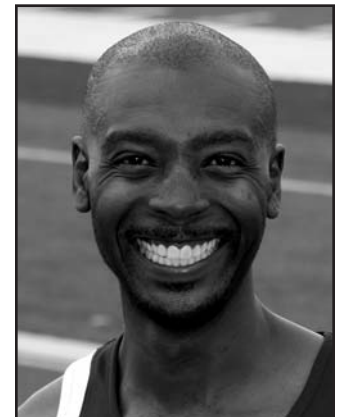

## McMurry's National Qualifiers

### Samantha Burgess | Mid-Distance | Senior | Ballinger | Ballinger High School



In her final year with McMurry's track team, Burgess was a part of the 4X400-meter relay team that qualified for nationals. Burgess won the American Southwest Conference titles and set conference records in the 800 and 1,500-meter races. She ran a 2:18.52 to beat a six-year old record in the 800 and a 4:58.18 in the 1,500-meter race to pass the previous record by over 10 seconds. **High School:** Ran track for head coach Tri Danley at Ballinger High School where she ran mid-distance events. She also lettered in basketball and cross country where she won the state title. **Personal:** 2003 graduate of Ballinger High School in Ballinger. Born 09 March 1985.

### Adam Davidson | Hurdles | Senior | Eastland | Eastland High School



Davidson ran the preliminary round of the 4X400-meter relay at the outdoor nationals in 2007 to help give rest to McMurry's Bert Green. With the addition of Davidson the relay team made it to the finals. In his final year he won the 110-meter and 400-meter hurdle titles at the American Southwest Conference Championships April 20. He ran a time of 14.76 seconds in the 110-meter hurdles at the ASC Championships, which was his personal best on the season that qualified him for the national meet. His time of 56.48 seconds in the 400-meter hurdles was 4.1 seconds better than his previous best and was enough to push him over the edge for the championship. **High School:** Ran track in high school and also lettered in football and track. **Personal:** 2003 graduate of Eastland High School in Eastland. Mother, Linda Davidson, graduated from McMurry in 2001. Born 28 March 1984.

### Amos Davidson | Mid-Distance / Distance | Sophomore-Transfer | Texas A&M-Commerce | Valley View



In his first season with the team, Davidson earned all-American status as a member of the men's 4X400-meter relay team that placed sixth at the national outdoor meet. He won the American Southwest Conference championship in both the 800-meter and 1,500-meter runs. He ran a time of 1:56.83 in the 800-meter race to set the ASC record. His time of 4:01.20 in the 1,500-meter race also set a conference record breaking a six-year old mark. **Texas A&M-Commerce:** Ran two years for NCAA Division II TAMC in cross country and one year in track. **High School:** Davidson was a four-year letterman for head coach Russell Glascock at Valley View High School. He qualified for regionals three times in the 1,600-meter race and twice in the 800-meter run. He was the state champion in the 1,600-meter race in his senior year and won second place in the 800. He also lettered in football, basketball, cross country, baseball and golf. **Personal:** 2005 graduate of Valley View High School in Valley View. Cousins, Clint and Brian Davidson, ran cross country at the University of Texas at Arlington.

**School:** Davidson was a four-year letterman for head coach Russell Glascock at Valley View High School. He qualified for regionals three times in the 1,600-meter race and twice in the 800-meter run. He was the state champion in the 1,600-meter race in his senior year and won second place in the 800. He also lettered in football, basketball, cross country, baseball and golf. **Personal:** 2005 graduate of Valley View High School in Valley View. Cousins, Clint and Brian Davidson, ran cross country at the University of Texas at Arlington.

### Thomas Dimitri | Pole Vault | Sophomore | Cross Plains | Cross Plains High School



Dimitri automatically qualified for the national outdoor meet in 2007 with a jump of 16 feet and six inches May 5 at the South Plains Invitational in Levelland. The sophomore reached the 16-foot plateau on three different occasions throughout the outdoor season. He was also an automatic qualifier for the national indoor meet. On April 20, in Clinton, Miss., he won the American Southwest Conference Championship with a jump of 15 feet even. **High School:** Competed as a pole vaulter at Cross Plains High School with a personal best of 15 feet. Also lettered in football. **Personal:** 2005 graduate of Cross Plains High School in Cross Plains. Born 05 Nov. 1986

### Quinesha Franklin | Sprints | Sophomore | Fort Worth | Haltom High School



Franklin was honored as an all-American for the first time in 2007 joining the 4X100-meter relay team to place eighth at the national outdoor meet. She helped the squad run a 48.04 second time in the finals. Franklin was also McMurry's top runner in the 100-meter dash in 2007. She ran the top three times in the race by a McMurry runner and qualified for the national outdoor meet. She ran a personal best of 12.18 seconds May 17 at the McMurry Twilight at Wilford Moore Stadium. Franklin was also a member of McMurry's 4X400-meter relay team that qualified for the national outdoor meet. **High School:** Franklin ran track at Haltom High School for head coach Jenifer Finnell and was an all-district performer in the 100 and 200-meter races. She was named her school's sprinter of the year in her junior and senior seasons. **Personal:** 2005 graduate of Haltom High School in Haltom City. Cousin, Stephanie Allen, runs track at the University of North Texas. Born 28 Sept. 1986.

### Molly Fuston | Sprints / Jumps | Freshman | Childress | Childress High School



In her first season with the team, Fuston made an early impression as she was named the American Southwest Conference's Female Freshman of the Year. She nationally qualified in the 200-meter race and was a member of both relay teams at the national meet. She earned all-America honors in the 4X100-meter relay helping the team run a time of 48.04 seconds. She placed fifth in the 400-meter dash, third in the high jump, second in the long jump and won the ASC title in the triple jump on April 20. **High School:** Fuston was a multi-sport athlete in Childress. She was especially a standout in volleyball where she was a district MVP and was the first all-state volleyball player in Childress. She was also an all-district performer in basketball, softball and track. **Personal:** 2006 graduate of Childress High School in Childress. Born 01 Aug. 1988.

### Bert Green | Sprints | Junior | Lafayette, Mo.



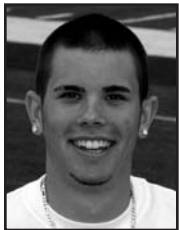
Green earned two more all-America honors during the 2007 track season by running with the national championship 4X100-meter relay team and the 4X400-meter relay team. He also qualified for the national outdoor meet in both the 100 and 200-meter dashes. In 2006, he was a three-time all-American at the national outdoor meet giving him a total of five all-America honors in a McMurry Uniform. **High School:** Played baseball for head coach Bob Swift at Lafayette High School in Missouri. Was a two-time all state selection and an all-America selection his senior season. Hit .456 had 15 homeruns and more than 20 stolen bases and played shortstop. Also lettered in basketball and was an AAU all-American in track. **Personal:** 1992 graduate of Lafayette High School in Missouri. A 10th-round draft pick by the St. Louis Cardinals in 1992. Had a nine-year professional baseball career including two stints with major league clubs. Played in 20 games for the St. Louis Cardinals in 1997 and combined for 97 games for the Texas Rangers in 1999 & 2000. Has a career major league batting average of .214. Holds the Texas Rangers' franchise single-game record for stolen bases in a game with five against the Seattle Mariners Sept. 28, 2000. Father, Bert, Sr., played semi-pro football and played collegiate ball at Washington State. Green was also an all-conference wide receiver and punter for McMurry's football team. Born 09 June 1974.

**Chris Kelley | Sprints | Sophomore | DeSoto High School | DeSoto**



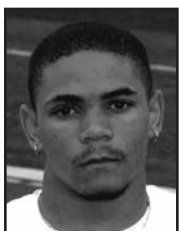
Kelley qualified for the 4X100-meter relay team in 2006 that went to nationals. However, he injured a hamstring before the national outdoor meet and had to sit out. In 2007, he got a chance to run in the meet again and made the most of it as he was a part of the first men's relay team in McMurry history to win a national championship. The men's 4X100-meter relay team won the national title with a time of 40.59 seconds. Kelley also ran the 400-meter race throughout the outdoor season and placed fourth at the American Southwest Conference Championships April 20 in Clinton, Miss. **High School:** Lettered in track and football at DeSoto High School where he was an all-district performer as a cornerback. **Personal:** 2003 graduate of DeSoto High School in DeSoto. Is a member of McMurry's football team and transferred from NCAA Division II West Texas A&M to play football. Born 21 March 1985.

**John Mikalik | Sprints / Mid Distance | Junior | Georgetown | Georgetown High School**



Mikalik enjoyed his second-straight solid outdoor track season in 2007. The junior tied assistant coach Brad Parris and teammate Bert Green for the third-most all-America honors earned by a McMurry trackster. In 2007, he was a member of the national championship 4X100-meter relay team and also earned all-America honors in the 4X400-meter relay while qualifying for nationals in the 400-meter dash. He won the American Southwest Conference title in the 400-meter dash and was a member of both relay teams that claimed conference championships. Mikalik was a member of the 4X100-meter relay team that posted the top time in NCAA Division III in 2007 with a time of 40.44 March 24 at Abilene Christian University. He was an all-American in 2006 in three different events including the 400-meter dash and both relays. **High School:** Ran four years for head coach Andrew Braun at Southwestern High School. He set the school record in the 200-meter dash and was a member of the 4X200-meter relay and the 4X400-meter relay teams that set district records. **Personal:** 2004 graduate of Georgetown High School in Georgetown. Born 21 May 1985.

**Hanneus Ollison | Sprints / Jumps | Sophomore | Colorado City | Colorado City High School**



In just his second season with McMurry's track team, Ollison has earned more all-America honors than any other McMurry track athlete in school history. The eight-time all-American won his second-straight Male South Region Athlete of the Year award. In 2007, he earned all-American status in the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes along with the 4X100-meter and the 4X400-meter relays. He also qualified for the national outdoor meet in the long jump as well. Ollison was a member of the first relay team at McMurry to win a national title when the 4X100-meter relay team won the title with a time of 40.59 seconds. He was a four-time all-American in 2006 after earning in honors in the same four events as 2007. Before nationals, he was the ASC's Outstanding Male Athlete of the Year. He won the 100 and 200-meter races and was a member of the 4X100-meter and 4X400-meter relay teams that won a conference title. He placed second in the long jump with an automatic qualifying mark of 23 feet and 8.5 inches. **High School:** Was a four-year letterman for head coach Dan Gainey at Colorado City High School. He was a three-time district champion in the 200-meter race and was a two-time regional champ in the event as well. He placed fourth at state in the 200-meter race as a senior. He also lettered in football and basketball where he was an all-district performer in both sports. He was named second team all-state as wide receiver and defensive back his senior year in football and was a first-team all-region selection in basketball his senior year. **Personal:** 2005 graduate of Colorado City High School in Colorado City. Born 17 July 1987.

**Zach Shew | High Jump | Sophomore – Transfer | Tarleton State | Tuscola**



Shew made an early impression for the 2007 season when he earned all-America honors at the national indoor track meet. Shew jumped six feet and 7.5 inches at the national meet to place eighth and become the first McMurry high jumper to earn indoor all-America status since Ryder Peacock did in 2004. In the outdoor season, Shew was a national qualifier and jumped a season high six feet and eight inches March 24 at Abilene Christian University.

**Taron Weaver | Sprints | Senior | Waco**



Weaver earned all-America honors in her fourth and final year with McMurry's track team. She was a member of the 4X100-meter team that placed eighth at the national outdoor meet with a time of 48.04 seconds. Weaver ran the top two times for McMurry in the 400-meter dash in 2007. She ran a personal best of 58.24 seconds to place third at the ASC Championships April 20 in Clinton, Miss.

**Richalle Wright | Sprints | Senior | Grand Prairie | South Grand Prairie High School**



Wright completed a four-year career with McMurry by adding her second outdoor all-America honor in 2007. In 2006, she was a member of the 4X400-meter relay team that earned all-American status and in 2007, she was a member of the all-American 4X100-meter relay team. Wright was also McMurry's top sprinter in the 200-meter dash all season for McMurry. She qualified for the national meet in the 200-meter race and ran a personal best of 25.04 seconds in the American Southwest Conference Championships April 20. Wright was also a member of the women's 4X400-meter relay team that qualified for the national outdoor meet. **High School:** Ran track for head coach Sharon Bruner at South Grand Prairie High School where she was the team captain. She also lettered in basketball and was an all-district performer. **Personal:** 2003 graduate of South Grand Prairie High School in Grand Prairie. Sister, Nichalle, played collegiate basketball at Wiley College. Born 15 Sept. 1984.

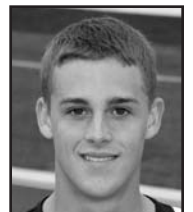

Another year - another successful season for McMurry's track programs. For the ninth straight season, the men's track team won the American Southwest Conference title; and for the eighth time in nine seasons, the women's team won the ASC title continuing as the conference's most dominant force in track and field.

During the indoor season, McMurry sent three runners to the national outdoor meet after sending just one in 2006. Hann Ollison, Thomas Dimitri and Zach Shew all represented McMurry in their respective events. However, it was Shew who brought home all-America honors after placing eighth in the high jump with a leap of six feet and 7.5 inches.

Then came the outdoor season, McMurry's bread and butter, and once again both teams were able to dominate the conference meet. The men won by over 200 points scoring 341 in the two-day event. Mississippi College's men followed with 122.5 points then Sul Ross finished third with 70.5 and Howard Payne rounded out the four teams with 68. The women scored 301 points while Texas Lutheran followed with 197 points, Mississippi College scored 83 and Sul Ross posted 18 points.

Ollison, the sophomore from Colorado City, was named the ASC's Outstanding Track Athlete of the Year while freshman Molly Fuston earned the top honor among female freshmen. Head coach Barbara Crousen was named the ASC Coach of the Year for both the men's and women's teams.

McMurry sent 13 athletes to the national outdoor championships in Osh Kosh, Wis. In a banquet honoring the national qualifiers the night before the three-day meet, Ollison and Crousen earned top regional honors. Ollison, for the second straight season, was named the NCAA West Region Male Athlete of the Year while Crousen was named the NCAA's West Region Male Coach of the Year.

On the men's side, Ollison individually qualified in the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes as well as the long jump. He also was a member of the 4X100-meter relay and the 4X400-meter relay squads. Junior Bert Green was a member of both relays and qualified in the 100-meter and 200-meter dashes.

Dimitri qualified in the pole vault and Shew qualified in the high jump. John Mikalik was a member of both relays and qualified in the 400-meter dash as well. Chris Kelley was a member of the 4X100-meter relay team and Adam Davidson qualified in the 110-meter hurdles and ran in the preliminaries with the 4X400-meter race. Amos Davidson qualified with the 4X400-meter team.

On the women's side, Quinesha Franklin qualified individually for the 100-meter race and ran with the women's 4X100-meter relay team. Richalle Wright and Fuston qualified in the 200-meter race both were members of the 4X100-meter and 4X400-meter relays.

Taron Weaver helped round out the 4X100-meter relay squad while Samantha Burgess took the fourth spot in the 4X400-meter relay.

The men, who placed fourth in the 2006 meet, were looking to make a run at the national title with many of the same competitors from a season ago. The team didn't get the overall performance it wanted, however, the 2007 squad was able to do some-

thing that the 2006 squad didn't: win a national title in an event.

The men's 4X100-meter relay team that carried the No. 1 time in the nation all season long became the first men's relay team in school history to take home a national title. The team comprised of Ollison, Green, Mikalik and Kelley ran a time of 40.59 seconds to win the gold.

The men's 4X400-meter relay team finished sixth and earned all-America honors. Ollison placed in the top eight in both the 100 and 200-meter dashes to gain all-American status in those events. On the women's side, the 4X100-meter relay team comprised of Fuston, Wright, Franklin and Weaver placed eighth to earn all-America status.

All in all, both of McMurry's teams combined to win 18 individual ASC titles, two relay titles and 10 athletes gained at least one all-America honor in 2007.

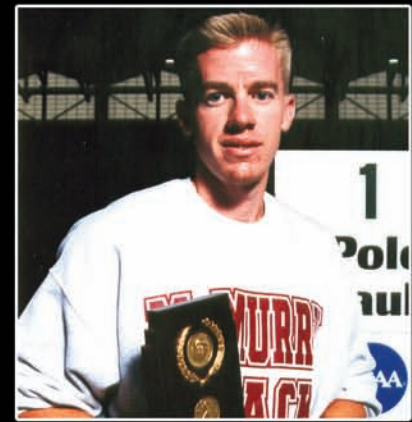

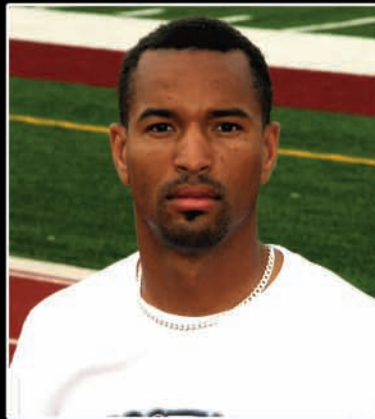

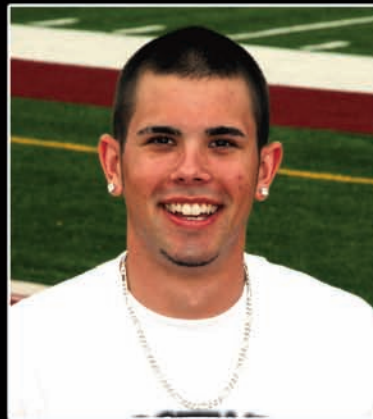
