THE SERIES

This is the seventh meeting between Rowan University and Western Connecticut State University. The Profs hold a 6-0 series advantage over the Colonials. Last year, Rowan defeated Western Connecticut, 40-18 in Danbury, CT. Prior, the Profs had wins of 24-17 (2006), 49-3 (2005), 43-7 (2004), 25-19 (2003) and 43-14 (2001).

LAST MEETING

Last season, Rowan defeated Western Connecticut State, 40-18 in Danbury, CT. Profs' superback Rob Richardson rushed for 175 yards and one touchdown, while superback Jon Downes added 81 yards and one TD. Quarterback Tim Hagerty completed four of seven passes for 71 yards and one touchdown. Wide receiver Billy Magill had four catches for 45 yards and a 16 yard TD catch. Rowan's defense held WestConn to 59 yards rushing. Linebackers Drew Yezzi and Chris Niszczak and defensive backs Eric Bailey and Elijah Bynum each made six tackles. Yezzi added 3.5 tackles for a loss (-22 yards) and 2.5 sacks (-20 yards). Defensive back Ahmad Stokes intercepted two passes and defensive back Clarence Days had one pick. For the Colonials, quarterback James Williams passed for 211 yards and two touchdowns on 20 completions in 36 attempts. Running back Wayne Neal contributed with 84 yards and one touchdown. Wide receiver Derrick Way made six grabs for 53 yards. Defensive end Kevin Marchant recorded a game-high 14 tackles. He added 3.5 tackles for a loss (-12 yards), 2.5 sacks (-10 yards) and one forced fumble. Linebackers Chad Milling and Ryan Delage contributed with nine and seven stops respectively. Defensive back Mike Negast had one interception. Rowan went up 6-0 on a 16 yard touchdown pass from Hagerty to Magill at 7:27 in the first quarter. At 3:03, Western Connecticut tied the game with a two yard TD run by Neal. In the second stanza, Rowan kicker Dan Roberts made a 22 (7:33) and a 27 yard field goal (0:06) to give the Profs a 12-6 halftime lead. At 12:41 in the third period, Downes rushed one yard for a touchdown. Just over two minutes later, wide receiver Adam Preciado had a 34 yard TD run. At 7:52, wide receiver Chris Kelly caught a 25 yard TD pass to cut the deficit to 26-12 following the missed PAT. Neal had an eight yard reception at 13:32 in the fourth quarter to make the score 26-18 after a failed two-point attempt. Richardson ran 36 yards for a TD (5:53) and Stokes returned a pick 38 yards for a touchdown (5:38) to seal the victory.

TCNJ received the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Championship Tournament. This year, the NJAC will increase to 10 teams with the addition of The College at Brockport and Morrisville State College.

NJAC COACHES PRESEASON POLL

SUNY Cortland was picked to finish first in the NJAC Preseason Coaches Poll. The Red Dragons received seven of the 10 first place votes. Montclair State and Rowan were second and third respectively, each earning one first place vote. The College at Brockport was fourth and was chosen as the dark horse. Defending conference champion, The College of New Jersey was selected fifth with one first place vote. Rounding out the poll were Kean, sixth, Western Connecticut State, seventh, Buffalo State, eighth, William Paterson, ninth and Morrisville State, 10th.

NJAC CHAMPIONSHIPS

Rowan has won the NJAC Championship 16 times, 14 outright and two shared. The Profs captured the conference title in 2006, 2005, 2004, 2002, 2001, 1997, 1995, 1993, 1992, 1991, 1977, 1976, 1975 and 1974. Rowan shared the NJAC Championship in 1972 and 1983.

NCAA TOURNAMENT

Since 1991, Rowan has made 13 appearances in the NCAA Championship Tournament. The Profs have a 30-13 mark in the national tournament. Rowan has played in the championship game, the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl, five times in the last 14 years (1999-98-96-95-93). In 2005, 2004, 2001, 1997 and 1992, Rowan reached the semifinals of the tournament.



THE COACHES

Rowan Head Coach

Jay Accorsi



This is Jay Accorsi's seventh season as head coach of the Rowan University football team. Accorsi took over the position after nine years as an assistant coach. In six seasons, he has guided the Profs to four conference titles and four NCAA appearances.

Last year, Rowan went 4-6. In 2006, the Profs advanced to the quarterfinals of the national tournament. Rowan reached the national semifinals in 2005 and 2004. Accorsi was selected the New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC) Coach of the Year in 2005, 2004 and 2002. He was also named the Maxwell Football Club Tri-State Coach of the Year in 2005.

Prior to Rowan, Accorsi was an assistant coaching the wide receivers and quarterbacks at Nichols College in Dudley, MA from 1989-93. Accorsi graduated in 1985 with a bachelor's degree in business administration. He earned a master's in sports science from the U.S. Sports Academy (Daphne, AL) in 1992 and a master's in business administration from Rowan in 1997.

At Nichols, Accorsi was a running back for four years and was captain of the football team his senior season. A native of Somers, CT, Accorsi attended Somers High School and graduated in 1981. He lettered in football, wrestling and baseball.

He is a member of the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) and the New Jersey Football Coaches Association (NJFCA). Accorsi continually attends various high school and youth organization clinics and is a common presenter for the Frank Glazier and Mega clinics. He has been the guest speaker for the Touchdown Club of South Jersey and a keynote speaker at the Rotary Bowl banquet.

Accorsi resides in Mullica Hill, NJ with his wife, Nancy and daughters, Gabrielle and Rachel and son, Jack.

Western Connecticut State Head Coach

John Burrell



This is John Burrell's seventh season as head coach at Western Connecticut State University.

He took over the position after six years as an assistant coach for the Colonials. He has a 35-29 overall record as head coach.

Last year, Western Connecticut finished with a 4-6 overall record and a 2-5 mark in the conference. In 2006, the Colonials had a 5-5 record and they were 2-5 in the conference. In 2005, WestConn had a 6-4 record and a 3-3 mark in the New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC). In 2004, Burrell guided WCSU to a 5-5 overall record and a 2-4 conference mark in the team's first season in the NJAC. The Colonials set 13 individual or team records and 12 players earned All-Conference honors. The football team had a 6-4 record in 2003 and a 7-3 mark in 2002.

Burrell came to WCSU in 1996 as a graduate assistant and coached the linebackers. From 1997-99, he was the defensive backs coach and with one season as the special teams coordinator.

Before his promotion to head coach, Burrell spent two years as the lone full-time assistant. A 1992 graduate from Middlebury College, Burrell was a running back from 1987-1990. In 1990, Burrell received the first annual Panther Award, presented to the player who most exemplifies the spirit and integrity of Middlebury football.

Burrell started his coaching career at his alma mater in 1991 and was there for two seasons. In addition, he was an assistant coach at Ellicottville Central School (NY) in 1995.

Burrell currently resides in Southbury, CT with his wife Erin.

THE PROFS

LAST GAME

On Saturday, Rowan defeated The College at Brockport, 37-20 in Brockport, NY. The Profs were led by quarterback Frank Wilczynski with 296 yards passing and four touchdowns on 22 of 35 completions. He also ran for a game-high 133 yards on 18 attempts. Wide receiver Davon Edwards made five catches for 59 yards and two touchdowns. Wideout Marcus Lee added 56 yards and one touchdown on three receptions. Superback Ryan Leafey compiled 66 yards receiving and 47 yards rushing. Defensive end Kyle Kane recorded a team-high seven tackles, one sack (-8 yards), two pass breakups and a forced fumble. Safety Mike Barone and linebacker Drew Yezzi posted six stops apiece. Yezzi also had one tackle for a loss (-1 yard), one pass breakup and a fumble recovery. Rowan went up 7-0 at 13:16 in the first quarter on an 18 yard touchdown catch by Edwards. Kicker Mark Getsinger connected on a 19 yard field goal at 9:30 in the second to give the Profs a 10-0 lead. Lee's 13 yard TD reception (4:44) and tight end Derek Piccini's 21 yard touchdown grab (:20) made the score 24-0 at the intermission. Brockport scored on a 21 yard TD pass at 12:21 in the third. Getsinger tacked on a 22 yard field goal at 9:28. In the fourth, the Golden Eagles found the end zone on a three yard rush at 14:55. Getsinger's 28 yard field goal at 10:48 put Rowan ahead 30-14. Brockport's final TD came on a three yard carry at 8:43. Wilczynski found Edwards with a 24 yard touchdown pass with 4:56 left to play.

NJAC AWARDS



Frank Wilczynski (jr. Pine Hill, NJ/Overbrook) Wilczynski was named this week's NJAC Offensive Player of the Week. In the win over The College of Brockport, he completed 22 of 35 passes for 296 yards and four touchdowns. He also led the Profs with 133 rushing yards on 18 carries. In the NJAC statistics, Wilczynski is fourth in pass efficiency (147.3), fifth in rushing (66.8) and total offense (234.8), tied for seventh in scoring (7.5) and eighth in passing (168.0).



Kyle Kane (jr. Toms River, NJ/Toms River N.) Kane was selected the NJAC Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against Brockport. He collected seven tackles, one sack (-8 yards), two pass breakups and one forced fumble. In the conference statistics, Kane ranks second in sacks (1.12) and he is tied for ninth with 5.5 tackles for a loss.

NJAC TEAM STATISTICS

Rowan leads the NJAC in kickoff returns (25.5) and sacks (17). The Profs are tied for first in turnover margin (+1.75), second in rush defense (73.5) and third in scoring defense (21.2), rushing offense (165.5), pass efficiency (153.6), pass efficiency defense (117.6), interceptions (5) and punting (33.7).

NJAC INDIVIDUAL STATISTICS

Punter Andrew Smith is first in the NJAC in punting (43.3). Getsinger is tied for first in field goal percentage (80.0), tied for second in field goals (1.0) and third in kick scoring (5.8). Yezzi is tied for fourth in tackles (8.5). Defensive end Justin Hinds is second in sacks (1.12) and tied for ninth in tackles for a loss (5.5). Defensive end Matt Hoffman is tied for eighth in sacks (0.5).

THE COLONIALS

LAST GAME

Last Saturday, Western Connecticut State beat Morrisville State, 40-6 in Morrisville, NY. Quarterback James Williams threw for 257 and three touchdowns, completing 20 of 31 pass attempts. Tailback Jason Santiago carried the ball 16 times for 80 yards and one touchdown. He also had an 11 yard touchdown grab. Wide receiver Keith Rosedom made four catches for 114 yards and one touchdown. Wideout Chris Kelly contributed with three receptions for 51 yards and one TD. Defensive end Deron Minor registered six tackles, including one tackle for a loss (-2 yards). Defensive backs Anthony Gulan, Javaris Brown, Tre' Johnson and linebacker Desmond Miller each posted four stops. Cornerback Jeremy Vides and defensive back Cliff Rone both had one interception. Santiago's 10 yard touchdown run gave the Colonials a 7-0 lead at 14:55 in the second quarter. Kicker James Campbell made a 23 yard field goal at 2:31. With 40 seconds left, Williams threw a 31 yard TD pass to Kelly to give Western Connecticut a 17-0 halftime advantage. At 9:21 in the third, Morrisville State scored on a 23 yard touchdown reception. Just over two minutes later, Santiago found the end zone on an 11 yard reception. Williams connected with Rosedom for a 32 yard touchdown pass at 12:39 in the fourth to put the Colonials up 31-6. Backup quarterback Chris App threw a 22 yard touchdown to tailback Lionel Assie at 9:50 and Campbell tacked on a 32 yard field goal at 5:46.

THE TEAM LEADER

Williams has stepped up as the Colonials' leader. In four games, the third year starter has thrown for 1,092 yards and 12 touchdowns. Williams has completed 86 of 138 passes and only tossed four interceptions. He is averaging 273.0 passing yards per game and has a 62.3 completion percentage. Williams leads the NJAC in passing (273.0). He is second in total offense (285.0) and third in pass efficiency (151.7).

THE TWO HORSEMEN

Western Connecticut State packs a lethal one-two punch at tailback. Santiago is the team leader with 143 yards and one touchdown on 40 rushes. He has 50 yards receiving and one TD on three catches. Wayne Neal has compiled 117 yards and one touchdown on 46 carries.

NJAC TEAM STATISTICS

The Colonials rank first in the conference in passing offense (280.5). They are second in total defense (292.2), third in pass defense (188.8) and fourth in pass efficiency (143.3) and total offense (357.8). WestConn is fifth in scoring (28.8) and rush defense (103.5), tied for fifth in scoring defense (24.8) and sacks (9) and sixth in pass efficiency defense (137.1).

NJAC INDIVIDUAL STATISTICS

Rosedom is fourth in the NJAC in receptions (5.8) and receiving yards (110.5) per game. He is fifth in all-purpose yards per game (158.0) and tied for seventh in touchdown scoring (6.0). Campbell ranks fourth in kick scoring (4.8) and fifth in field goals (0.75). Punter Billy Thompson is eighth in punting (36.2). Milling is tied for 18th in tackles (7.0), while safety Mike Negast is tied for third in passes defended (1.50). Minor is tied for eighth in sacks (0.5) and tied for 11th in tackles for a loss (5.0).
