### START ME UP:

Marian University field hockey continues its four-game homestand hosting Denison Saturday, Sept. 19 at 11 a.m.

### GOALS ON GOALS ON GOALS:

The Sabre offense has had a strong start to the season ranking second in the CFHC, 27th in the nation, averaging 3.33 goals per game. Charlotte Touw and Shaelyn Klassen each rank in the top three of the CFHC for goals per game.

### A KLASSEN ACT:

Shaelyn Klassen was named the CFHC Offensive Player of the Week after her seven-point weekend against DePauw and Wittenberg. Klassen opened the weekend with the second multi-goal game of her career against DePauw with her second goal serving as the game-winning score.

### DEPENDING ON DENISON:

The favorite to win the NCAC, Denison enters after defeating Wooster 8-1 to open its conference play. Reilly Desmond and Emma Gebhart are each averaging at least a goal per game for the Big Red.

## MARIAN UNIVERSITY FIELD HOCKEY HISTORY

- Marian University field hockey was introduced as the 26th intercollegiate sport at Marian in September of 2021.
- The Sabres finished 7-8 in its inaugural season with a 2-3 conference record to earn the No. 3 seed for the SAA Tournament.
- Marian had its first winning season in 2023 after going 9-6 with a 5-3 SAA mark.
- Allyson Nichols was the SAA Newcomer of the Year and earned All-Region recognition in 2022.

## WELCOME TO SMITH FIELD

- Smith Field was built in 2002 and hosts field hockey, soccer, and lacrosse.
- Originally a grass pitch, Smith Field went under renovation in 2019 building a new turf surface.
- Smith Field features a customizable scoreboard, full-service concession stand, men and women restrooms, team rooms, and lights to allow for night games. The second floor of Smith Field features a state-of-the-art press box and meeting room.
