AGGIEHITS

1. UC Davis most recently fell on the road at No. 17/17 SMU, 56-10, on Saturday, Sept. 12 at Gerald J. Ford Stadium in Dallas, Texas.
2. Jackson Kollock (QB #12) and Coby Herman (RB #24) both scored their first collegiate touchdown at SMU as the pair connected on a four-yard strike to get the Aggies on the scoreboard at 11:18 in the fourth quarter.
3. Robert Meyer, who is originally from nearby Colfax, Calif., connected on his first field goal as an Aggie with 3:35 remaining in regulation. It was also the team's first made field goal this season.
4. Four Aggies recorded at least three solo tackles: Brayden Rosa, Drew Faulkner, Chaz Gilbreath, Teeg Slone, and Nick Afato. Faulkner finished second on the team in total tackles with five.

PLAYING EXPERIENCE

Tim Plough returned to his alma mater to become the 18th head coach in UC Davis football history in December of 2023. The 2026 season will be his third at the helm of the Aggies. On Feb. 1, 2026, Plough signed a five-year extension, keeping him in Davis until 2031.

In the two seasons since taking over the Aggies and returning home, Plough has brought unprecedented success to Davis. He has guided the Aggies to a 20-7 record, with back-to-back top-five finishes nationally and top-eight NCAA FCS Playoff seeds, which have resulted in three home playoff games. UC Davis has also made two straight trips to the NCAA FCS Playoff Quarterfinals, marking the first time since 2001-02 the Aggies have reached consecutive quarterfinal rounds.

In 2025, Plough led an explosive Aggie squad to a 9-4 record while having the 10th-best offense and 12th-best passing attack in the nation. UC Davis recorded ranked wins over No. 14 Northern Arizona and No. 9 Rhode Island, while once again ranking among the best in the nation as the Aggies finished 2026 ranked No. 8, and they found themselves on national television a school record four times.

When the season came to an end, Plough had helped coach five All-Americans, and under the overwatch of Plough, Jacob Psyk was named a Buck Buchanan Award Finalist and Caden Pinnick was named a Jerry Rice Award Finalist. Defender Rex Connors also set the school record for career tackles, setting the mark early in the season, cementing his legacy as one of the best defensive backs to wear the Blue & Gold.

During 2024, the Aggies set a new bar for excellence, and under the first-year tutelage of Plough, UC Davis won a school-record 11 games, going 11-3 to finish No. 5 in the nation, the highest in the program's FCS history. UC Davis would go on to reach the quarterfinals of the NCAA FCS Playoffs, getting a second-round home win over No. 12 Illinois State after earning a first-round bye as one of the best programs in the nation.

Plough's 11-3 record was the best for a first-year head coach in the nation during the 2024 season, and his 11 wins are the most by an Aggie first-year head coach, passing legendary Aggie head coach Bob Biggs. Plough was honored for his first-year successes by being named the AFCA Region Five Coach of the Year and an Eddie Robinson Award finalist.

2024 was also a season of firsts, and under Plough the Aggies got the program's first win over Eastern Washington, a victory on ESPN2 at then-ranked No. 7 Montana and a win over then-ranked No. 5 Idaho for a victory over the highest-ranked program in Aggie history.

Individually, under Plough, UC Davis produced several All-Americans in 2024 as Miles Hastings, David Meyer, Ian Larison and Rex Connors all earned All-American honors to give UC Davis the most All-Americans in one season in program history. UC Davis also set 19 individual records and six team records during a record-setting year.

Records that stood out were Hastings becoming the first Aggie quarterback to throw for over 4,000 yards, Larison locking up the career all-purpose yards record, and both Meyer and Connors setting and breaking each other's single-season solo tackles record.

THE SERIES

UC Davis and Stetson will face off for the first time on Saturday evening, with neither program having previously scheduled the other prior to this matchup. Stetson competes in the Pioneer Football League (PFL), which will mark the second opponent from this league UC Davis has faced this season. San Diego, who the Aggies defeated 49-17 on Sept. 5, is also a member of the PFL.

A PAIR OF FIRSTS

Jackson Kollock (QB #12) and Coby Herman (RB #24) both scored their first collegiate touchdowns at SMU as the pair connected on a four-yard strike at 11:18 in the fourth quarter to put the first points of the game on the scoreboard for the Aggies. Kollock transferred to UC Davis after spending his freshman year at Minnesota, while Herman joined the Aggies as a true freshman out of La Costa Canyon High School in Encinitas, Calif.

AN AGGIE WIN WOULD ...

Give the team its eleventh straight win in its home opener. UC Davis has won ten straight home openers to date, having last dropped its first game at home in 2015 (L, 27-17 to South Dakota). Last season, the Aggies took down Southern Utah, 50-34, on Sept. 20, 2025, highlighted by 172 yards and two touchdowns from Jordan Fisher.

TREYNOR IMPRESSES DOWN SOUTH

In Week 2 against San Diego, Aggie quarterback Treynor Cleeland put the rest of the league on notice after throwing five touchdown passes against the Toreros. Cleeland becomes the program's second straight starting QB to throw for five TDs in a game after Caden Pinnick did it in two separate contests last season.

PEREZS BREAKOUT GAME

Now in his sixth year with the Aggies, running back Matteo Perez broke out against San Diego, going for a career-high 123 yards highlighted by a 79-yard touchdown run. This was the first 100+ yard game for Perez in his Davis career.

AN ALL-TIME GREAT COMEBACK IN HILLSBORO

Down 21 points entering halftime in the season opener vs. Portland State, the Aggies mounted an all-time great comeback. Starting with the program's first safety since 2018, Davis scored 31 of the game's last 34 points, capped off by a 22-yd pass from Treynor Cleeland to Laviel Pickett with seconds remaining.

CLEELAND MAKES HIS DEBUT

After earning the starting QB job following a grueling fall camp, Treynor Cleeland debuted to fanfare for the Aggies, going 22-for-39 for 287 yards and two touchdowns against Portland State.

ALL-AMERICAN AGGIES

With the Stats Perform and FCS Central All-American teams released to the public, four Aggies have landed on both teams: Sam Gbatu Jr., Rex Connors, Porter Connors, and Winston Williams. In addition, Drew Cofield and Jordan Fisher have also been tabbed as FCS Central All-Americans.

UC DAVIS FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

ESPN COMES TO DAVIS

For the first time in the regular season, and the second time in program history, the Aggies will be broadcast at UC Davis Health Stadium on a linear ESPN network. The team's Homecoming matchup with Eastern Washington on Oct. 3 will be broadcast to the world on ESPN2 starting at 7:30 p.m. PT.

BUCKED FOR THE THIRD STRAIGHT YEAR

Now in his fifth season in the blue and gold, Rex Connors has been tabbed as a preseason Buck Buchanan Award watch list selection. Connors earns this honor despite being limited to only four games of action a season ago. This marks the third straight season that Connors has landed on the award's preseason watch list.

SAM IS SHORT FOR SWEETNESS

Senior wide receiver Samuel Gbatu, Jr. earned a spot on the 2026 Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List, presented annually to the nation's top offensive player in the FCS. Sam earned this honor after leading the conference in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns in 2025. He also becomes the first Aggie to earn a spot on the list since legend Keelan Doss in 2018.

LOOMING LARGE IN BIG SKY COUNTRY

Following the team's strong finish to last season, the Big Sky Conference has taken notice of the Aggies after naming seven to the league's preseason all-conference team. The list was made up of Sam Gbatu Jr., Winston Williams, Zaire Collier, Rayne Mayo Jr., Porter Connors, Rex Connors, and Drew Cofield.

GOOD WORKS ZAIRE

For the second straight season, an Aggie has found themselves celebrated across the nation on the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Following former kicker Hunter Ridley's honor in 2025, center Zaire Collier has been honored this season for his commitment to community service, academic achievement, and leadership.

COOL LIKE COFIELD

After being only one of two true freshmen to start every game a season ago, incoming sophomore Drew Cofield has felt the love from the nation, already being named an FCS Central All-American following a Freshman All-American nod in 2025. He was also the only sophomore among all 11 teams in the conference to head to Big Sky Kickoff in Spokane in July.

HEROS ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BALL

Over the course of the offseason, UC Davis saw many of its returners honored by publication HERO Sports. Among those honored are Samuel Gbatu, Jr., Porter Connors, Jordan Fisher, Zaire Collier, Winston Williams, Rex Connors, Drew Cofield, and Sam Goligoski.

FRESH FACES ON THE COACHING STAFF

Among the changes for the Aggies in 2026 are the hiring of two new coaches, Cody vonAppen and Vavae Malepeai. vonAppen joins the team as the special teams coordinator after five seasons as the defensive coordinator at Cal Poly. Malepeai comes on as the running backs coach after three seasons as a Quality Control Analyst for Stanford.

During the 2025 offseason, UC Davis athletics proudly announced that, thanks to the contributions from The Arp Family Foundation, the UC Davis football defensive line coaching position was renamed the Jane and Fred Arp Defensive Line Coach. Fred was a former Aggie and is a member of the Cal Aggie Athletics Hall of Fame. He spent 41 seasons on the coaching staff at Davis.

LIGHTING THE WATER TOWER

Last season, UC Davis refurbished Touchdown Tower and installed brand-new Victory Lights to elevate the game-day environment. Fans can watch for the tower to light up after every Aggie football win, as well as other key UC Davis athletics victories throughout the year.

AGGIE ASCENT - IMPROVING THE AGGIE FACILITIES

Announced in November 2025, Aggie Ascent represents one of the most significant facility upgrades in UC Davis history. The \$265M plan modernizes and expands key athletics venues — football stadium, softball, track & field, golf, and more. Designed to match the university's ambition, support student-athletes, and elevate the fan experience. The UC Davis Health Stadium will include: New premium suites and club seating to elevate fan experience and hospitality. Upgraded concourse and press box for an improved game-day environment. 8,500 sq. ft. event space for up to 500 guests, with a catering kitchen, two bars, and restrooms.

NAMESAKES

Two landmarks stand near the main entrance of UC Davis Health Stadium, both named after key university figures. The victory bell is named for Thomas Tavernetti, a university faculty member from 1913 to 1930... The bell is mentioned in the school fight song, "Aggie Fight," and rung after each home win... Across the plaza is a statue of Jim Sochor, who served as UC Davis head football coach from 1970-88... Sochor won 156 games and 17 conference titles in his career, and instilled a belief system later known as "Aggie Pride" (see below).

THE TOOM

Before moving to Aggie Stadium (UC Davis Health Stadium) in 2007, UC Davis football played almost six decades' worth of its home games at the corner of Russell Boulevard and A Street in a venue opened in 1949 and named for athletics director Crip Toomey in 1962... Toomey Field, or "The Toom" as it is known to many an alum, hosted a total of 286 Aggie home football contests, including nationally televised NCAA semifinal games in 1977 (Lehigh), 1982 (North Dakota State), and 1983 (NDSU)

AGGIE PRIDE

The term has since been appropriated by various entities on the Davis campus, but the Aggie Pride belief system has its roots with the football program. After taking the helm in 1970, head coach Jim Sochor instilled a new culture: "We knew that everybody we played would be bigger, stronger and faster than we were. We had to find a way. And that way was that no one would be closer as a football team than we would be. Our central values became trust, unity, and togetherness." Bob Foster, the long-time Sochor assistant, is credited with giving Aggie Pride its name.



UC DAVIS FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

-Treyner Cleeland made his Aggie debut against Portland State on Aug. 29, going 22-for-39 with 287 yards and a pair of touchdowns.

-Against San Diego, Cleeland put the world on notice with five touchdown passes, a feat previously done by Caden Pinnick and Aggie legend Jake Maier.

-Backing up Cleeland is Jackson Kollock, a second-year transfer from Minnesota. Kollock recently scored his first collegiate touchdown at SMU.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

-Continuing his momentum from last season, Jordan Fisher got the start in the opener against Portland State, rushing for 65 yards and two scores.

-In the second game against San Diego, Matteo Perez finished with a career-high 123 rushing yards, going over 100 yards for the first time in a single game in his career. This performance was highlighted by a 79-yard run in the third quarter that helped seal the win against the Toreros.

-Freshman Coby Herman also recently scored his first collegiate touchdown at SMU, crossing the plane on a four-yard pass from Jackson Kollock.

TIGHT END NOTEBOOK

-Coming back from an injury that cut his 2025 season short, Winston Williams has felt the love from the nation after being named an FCS Central and Stats Perform Preseason All-American along with an All-Big Sky preseason selection.

-With Williams being kept out of action against Portland State, Edward Khutshishvili gets the start at tight end. Khutshishvili caught three passes for 47 yards against the Vikings.

-Khutshishvili scored his first touchdown of the season at San Diego.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

-Despite the graduation of Eli Simonsen, UC Davis returns a large number of their offensive linemen from last season. Leading the group is senior center Zaire Collier, who was named a nominee for the Allstate Good Works Team.

-Other returners include Davis native AJ Hasson, David Main, Roice Cleeland, and Jayden Montanez.

-Consistency on the line proved to be paramount against Portland State, as the boys up front limited the Vikings to a single sack all afternoon. One week later, the line finished with a clean slate, giving up 0 sacks at San Diego.

WIDE RECEIVERS NOTEBOOK

-After countless preseason accolades, Samuel Gbatu Jr. responded to the noise with a 107-yard performance in the opener against Portland State. This mark gave Gbatu Jr. his 17th career contest with 100+ receiving yards.

-Gbatu Jr. had another 100+ receiving-yard performance against San Diego with 129. He also added a pair of TDs to his total.

-Wide receivers LaDanian Streets and Zach Jones also make their return after big seasons.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

-Devin Huegel enjoyed some bright spots on the road at No. 17/17 as he finished with three total tackles (one solo) and 0.5 tackles for loss.

-Alongside Huegel, Jaden Few tallied two total tackles (one solo) and one tackle for loss (1 yard) against the Mustangs.

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

-In his first game back from injury in 11 months, Porter Connors racked up eight total tackles (six solo) to tie for the team lead in the win at Portland State. He also added a sack against the Vikings. The Pleasant Grove, Utah native then followed with four tackles (all solo) in the win at San Diego, and two tackles (both assisted) at No. 17/17 SMU.

-Nick Afato added four tackles this past Saturday, tying for the team lead with three solo tackles against the Mustangs. Macray Madruga also tallied three tackles (all assisted) and 0.5 tackles for loss (1 yard).

DEFENSIVE BACK NOTEBOOK

-Drew Cofield and Hayden John, both making starts against Portland State, tied for the team lead with eight total tackles. Both men were also all over the backfield, each collecting a tackle for loss.

-Teeg Slone made his mark despite the loss at No. 17/17 SMU, recording two tackles for loss (13 yards) and one sack (9 yards). He also tied for the team lead with three solo tackles (finished with four total).

- Making his second start of his career, Brayden Rosa was all over the field in the win at San Diego, leading the team with six tackles and recording his first career interception. SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

-Robert Meyer, who is originally from nearby Colfax, Calif., transferred to UC Davis this past offseason after serving as Missouri's kicker in 2025. Meyer converted on his first field goal as an Aggie at No. 17/17 SMU, drilling a 33-yarder with 3:35 left in the fourth quarter. It also marked the first field goal of the season for UC Davis as a team.

-Punter Dylan Mauro is back for the Aggies after totaling 1,750 yards last year. In his first game of 2026, Mauro pinned the Vikings with 293 punting yards, including two of over 50 yards. At No. 17/17 SMU, Mauro finished with 246 yards, including a long of 51 yards.

-Joseph Adema also returns as the team's primary holder.

No. 6 UC Davis football (2-1) fought until the final whistle on Saturday afternoon as No. 17/17 SMU (2-0) defeated the Aggies, 56-10, at Gerald J. Ford Stadium.

Jackson Kollock and Coby Herman both scored their first collegiate touchdowns in the contest, connecting on a four-yard strike at 11:18 in the fourth quarter.

Treynor Cleeland found Samuel Gbatu, Jr. for six yards to give UC Davis its first first down of the game at 13:21 in the opening quarter, but the Mustangs held off the Aggies on their first drive. SMU proceeded to start the scoring (7-0) with an eight-play, 90-yard drive capped off by a touchdown from Kendrick Raphael at 6:39.

The Mustangs added to their lead with a three-play, 75-yard drive as the first quarter wound down, finished off by a 52-yard touchdown from Kevin Jennings to Derrick McFall to make it 14-0.

With 12:32 left in the second quarter, Jennings tallied his second passing touchdown of the afternoon as Theo Melin Ohrstrom scored to put SMU up three scores, 21-0.

Less than three minutes later, the Mustangs continued to roll with another two-yard touchdown from Jennings, this time caught by Randy Pittman Jr., to increase their advantage to 28-0 at 10:27.

In the final minute of the opening half, SMU found the end zone twice more, scoring with 58 seconds and 29 seconds to take a 42-0 lead into the locker room at halftime.

Both offenses slowed a bit to open the second half, as the Mustangs did not score again until Ty Hawkins found Zach Turner from eight yards out to make it 49-0 in favor of SMU. UC Davis scored their first points of the game on a pair of firsts as Minnesota transfer Jackson Kollock found Coby Herman on a four-yard touchdown at 11:20 in the fourth quarter. Following another touchdown from Hawkins and SMU, Robert Meyer converted on a 33-yard field goal with 3:35 remaining to push the Aggies into double digits.

Both sides held steady for the remainder of the contest as SMU picked up its second win of the season by a final score of 56-10.
