1. UC Davis raced past Stetson in its last time out, defeating the Hatters 45-7 on Saturday, Sept. 19, in the 2026 home opener at UC Davis Health Stadium.
2. Zach Jones became the first Aggie in the modern era to return two punts for a touchdown in a single game, housing kicks of 79 yards and 61 to finish with a school-record and career-high 140 punt return yards.
3. Samuel Gbatu Jr. also showed out against the Hatters, finishing with new career-highs in receptions (10) and receiving yards (172). He scored his 25th career receiving touchdown, tying him for fourth all-time in school history.
4. Jones, Gbatu Jr., and Porter Connors swept this week's Big Sky POTW awards.

PLAYING EXPERIENCE

Tim Plough returned to his alma mater to become the 18th head coach in UC Davis football history in December of 2023. The 2026 season will be his third at the helm of the Aggies. On Feb. 1, 2026, Plough signed a five-year extension, keeping him in Davis until 2031.

In the two seasons since taking over the Aggies and returning home, Plough has brought unprecedented success to Davis. He has guided the Aggies to a 20-7 record, with back-to-back top-five finishes nationally and top-eight NCAA FCS Playoff seeds, which have resulted in three home playoff games. UC Davis has also made two straight trips to the NCAA FCS Playoff Quarterfinals, marking the first time since 2001-02 the Aggies have reached consecutive quarterfinal rounds.

In 2025, Plough led an explosive Aggie squad to a 9-4 record while having the 10th-best offense and 12th-best passing attack in the nation. UC Davis recorded ranked wins over No. 14 Northern Arizona and No. 9 Rhode Island, while once again ranking among the best in the nation as the Aggies finished 2026 ranked No. 8, and they found themselves on national television a school record four times.

When the season came to an end, Plough had helped coach five All-Americans, and under the overwatch of Plough, Jacob Psyk was named a Buck Buchanan Award Finalist and Caden Pinnick was named a Jerry Rice Award Finalist. Defender Rex Connors also set the school record for career tackles, setting the mark early in the season, cementing his legacy as one of the best defensive backs to wear the Blue & Gold.

During 2024, the Aggies set a new bar for excellence, and under the first-year tutelage of Plough, UC Davis won a school-record 11 games, going 11-3 to finish No. 5 in the nation, the highest in the program's FCS history. UC Davis would go on to reach the quarterfinals of the NCAA FCS Playoffs, getting a second-round home win over No. 12 Illinois State after earning a first-round bye as one of the best programs in the nation.

Plough's 11-3 record was the best for a first-year head coach in the nation during the 2024 season, and his 11 wins are the most by an Aggie first-year head coach, passing legendary Aggie head coach Bob Biggs. Plough was honored for his first-year successes by being named the AFCA Region Five Coach of the Year and an Eddie Robinson Award finalist.

2024 was also a season of firsts, and under Plough the Aggies got the program's first win over Eastern Washington, a victory on ESPN2 at then-ranked No. 7 Montana and a win over then-ranked No. 5 Idaho for a victory over the highest-ranked program in Aggie history.

Individually, under Plough, UC Davis produced several All-Americans in 2024 as Miles Hastings, David Meyer, Ian Larison and Rex Connors all earned All-American honors to give UC Davis the most All-Americans in one season in program history. UC Davis also set 19 individual records and six team records during a record-setting year.

Records that stood out were Hastings becoming the first Aggie quarterback to throw for over 4,000 yards, Larison locking up the career all-purpose yards record, and both Meyer and Connors setting and breaking each other's single-season solo tackles record.

THE SERIES

Saturday's game between UC Davis and Montana will mark the 12th meeting all-time between the two programs. The Grizzlies currently hold a 9-2 advantage over the Aggies, but UC Davis came out victorious, 30-14, in the last matchup between the two on Nov. 9, 2024, in Missoula. The Aggies have also never won back-to-back games over Montana.

AN AGGIE WIN WOULD ...

Give the Aggies their first-ever win over Montana in the city of Davis, having previously dropped all five matchups. The most recent loss came in a narrow 31-23 result on Oct. 7, 2023, at UC Davis Health Stadium.

HOME SWEET HOME

With the win over Stetson on Saturday night, UC Davis won its eleventh straight home opener, dating back to 2016. The Aggies last dropped their first game at home in a 27-17 loss to South Dakota on Sept. 12, 2015. Additionally, the victory over the Hatters marked the 60th win for the Aggies at UC Davis Health Stadium, which officially began its 20th season of operation on Saturday. It also marked the 100th home game inside the stadium for UC Davis, with the Aggies holding a record of 60-40 since it opened in 2007 (previously named Aggie Stadium).

CLEAN SWEEP

The Aggies swept this week's Big Sky Player of the Week honors as Samuel Gbatu Jr. was named Offensive Player of the Week, Porter Connors was named Defensive Player of the Week, and Zach Jones was named Special Teams Player of the Week. For UC Davis, it marked the second time ever the Aggies have swept the weekly Big Sky Player of the Week Awards. The first time came when Hunter Rodrigues (Offensive), Cole Hansen (Defensive), and Isaiah Thomas (Special Teams) swept the awards in Week 4 of the 2020-21 COVID-shortened season.

INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

Zach Jones electrified the UC Davis crowd in its home opener against Stetson as the Daly City native became the first Aggie in the modern era to return two punts for a touchdown in a single game. First, the Daly City native returned a punt 79 yards for a touchdown at 8:59 in the opening quarter, putting UC Davis up 21-0. The touchdown marked the Aggies' first punt return for a touchdown since Trent Tompkins returned a punt 85 yards at San Diego on Sept. 11, 2021. It was also the fifth-longest (79 yards) punt return touchdown in school history. Jones also showed out in the second half, returning a second punt for a touchdown at 3:07 in the third quarter to make it 38-0 in favor of the Aggies. In total, Jones finished with 140 punt return yards against Stetson, a new school record for a single game. It also marked a new career-high for Jones.

BUY STOCK NOW

Gbatu Jr. showed why he is one of the best players in the country yet again on Saturday night, setting new career-highs in receptions (10) and receiving yards (172). The wide receiver broke free throughout the evening, including a 46-yard touchdown from Cleeland in the first quarter. This score was also his 25th career receiving touchdown, tying him with Charley Enos for fourth in school history. It marked his third 100+ yard receiving game this year, and his 12th career game with 100+ receiving yards. With

this performance, he also passed Tony Kays to move into sixth all-time in school history in receiving yards with 2,780 and counting.

CLIMBING THE LEADERBOARDS

Gbatu Jr. continues to climb the leaderboards nationally as the wide receiver now ranks in the top five in the country in receiving yards (498, second), receptions per game (8.00, fourth), receiving yards per game (117.0, fifth), and receiving touchdowns (4, tied for fifth).

TREYNOR KEEPS SLINGING IT

Treynor Cleeland continues to improve with every opportunity as the quarterback dazzled from the pocket against Stetson, finishing with new career-highs in passing yards (331) and completions (26). It also marked the first 300+ yard passing game of his collegiate career. Notably, Cleeland's 46-yard touchdown to Gbatu Jr. at 1:12 in the first quarter marked the longest play of his career so far.

CONNORS THE CREATOR

Porter Connors had his way defensively for the Aggies on Saturday night as the linebacker finished with a game-high 10 tackles, four of which were solo, one tackle for loss (-2 yards), and one forced fumble. The performance marked the sixth time in his career and second time this season he has finished with ten total tackles or more. The forced fumble was his first of his career. The tackle for loss was his second this season.

FAMILIAR REINFORCEMENTS

For the first time this season, Trent Carrade and Winston Williams returned to action, providing a spark on both sides of the ball for UC Davis. Carrade finished Saturday's game with two tackles (one solo), one tackle for loss (-8 yards), and one sack (-8 yards). Williams recorded two catches for 15 yards, including a 10-yard gain from Cleeland in the third quarter.

FIRST CAREER SCORE COMES AT THE CRIB

Kai Acia joined the scoring party against Stetson with his first career touchdown, plunging in from three yards out with 33 seconds remaining in regulation. The touchdown was the second rushing touchdown of the game for the Aggies, as Jordan Fisher opened the scoring at 8:39 in the first quarter.

ESPN COMES TO DAVIS

For the first time in the regular season, and the second time in program history, the Aggies are set to appear on a linear ESPN network. The team's Homecoming matchup with Eastern Washington on Oct. 3 will air live on ESPN2 starting at 7:30 p.m. PT.

FRESH FACES ON THE COACHING STAFF

Among the changes for the Aggies in 2026 are the hiring of two new coaches, Cody vonAppen and Vavae Malepeai. vonAppen joins the team as the special teams coordinator after five seasons as the defensive coordinator at Cal Poly. Malepeai comes on as the running backs coach after three seasons as a Quality Control Analyst for Stanford.

CLUB FRED IS OPEN FOR BUSINESS

During the 2025 offseason, UC Davis athletics proudly announced that, thanks to the contributions from The Arp Family Foundation, the UC Davis

football defensive line coaching position was renamed the Jane and Fred Arp Defensive Line Coach. Fred was a former Aggie and is a member of the Cal Aggie Athletics Hall of Fame. He spent 41 seasons on the coaching staff at Davis.

LIGHTING THE WATER TOWER

Last season, UC Davis refurbished Touchdown Tower and installed brand-new Victory Lights to elevate the game-day environment. Fans can watch for the tower to light up after every Aggie football win, as well as other key UC Davis athletics victories throughout the year.

AGGIE ASCENT - IMPROVING THE AGGIE FACILITIES

Announced in November 2025, Aggie Ascent represents one of the most significant facility upgrades in UC Davis history. The \$265M plan modernizes and expands key athletics venues — football stadium, softball, track & field, golf, and more. Designed to match the university's ambition, support student-athletes, and elevate the fan experience. The UC Davis Health Stadium will include: New premium suites and club seating to elevate the fan experience and hospitality. Upgraded concourse and press box for an improved game-day environment. 8,500 sq. ft. event space for up to 500 guests, with a catering kitchen, two bars, and restrooms.

NAMESAKES

Two landmarks stand near the main entrance of UC Davis Health Stadium, both named after key university figures. The victory bell is named for Thomas Tavernetti, a university faculty member from 1913 to 1930... The bell is mentioned in the school fight song, "Aggie Fight," and rung after each home win... Across the plaza is a statue of Jim Sochor, who served as UC Davis head football coach from 1970-88... Sochor won 156 games and 17 conference titles in his career, and instilled a belief system later known as "Aggie Pride" (see below).

THE TOOM

Before moving to Aggie Stadium (UC Davis Health Stadium) in 2007, UC Davis football played almost six decades' worth of its home games at the corner of Russell Boulevard and A Street in a venue opened in 1949 and named for athletics director Crip Toomey in 1962... Toomey Field, or "The Toom" as it is known to many an alum, hosted a total of 286 Aggie home football contests, including nationally televised NCAA semifinal games in 1977 (Lehigh), 1982 (North Dakota State), and 1983 (NDSU).

AGGIE PRIDE

The term has since been appropriated by various entities on the Davis campus, but the Aggie Pride belief system has its roots with the football program. After taking the helm in 1970, head coach Jim Sochor instilled a new culture: "We knew that everybody we played would be bigger, stronger, and faster than we were. We had to find a way. And that way was that no one would be closer as a football team than we would be. Our central values became trust, unity, and togetherness." Bob Foster, the long-time Sochor assistant, is credited with giving Aggie Pride its name.



UC DAVIS FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

QUARTERBACK NOTEBOOK

-Cleeland continued to sling the rock against Stetson, finishing with a career-high 331 yards along with a career-high 26 completions. It also marked the first 300+ yard passing game of his career. He has now had at least two passing touchdowns in three of his first four games to begin his career.

-Against San Diego, Cleeland put the nation on notice with five touchdown passes, a feat previously done by Caden Pinnick and Aggie legend Jake Maier.

RUNNING BACK NOTEBOOK

-Jordan Fisher enjoyed success once again on Saturday night, rushing for 68 yards on 14 carries (4.6 average) and a touchdown. His 68 yards were a game-high as he finished with a long run of 14 yards.

-Matteo Perez provided a spark for UC Davis towards the end of the first half, ripping off a 21-yard run down the sideline before getting out of bounds to help the Aggies complete an 8-play, 99.5-yard drive.

-Alongside Fisher and Perez, Kai Acia joined the scoring party by recording his first career touchdown with a three-yard rush in the fourth quarter.

TIGHT END NOTEBOOK

-Coming back from an injury that cut his 2025 season short, Winston Williams returned to action against Stetson, recording two catches for 15 yards in the victory. His longest play came on a 10-yard pass from Cleeland in the third quarter. Before the season, Williams felt the love nationally after being named an FCS Central and Stats Perform Preseason All-American, along with an All-Big Sky preseason selection.

-Having filled the hole of Williams for the past few weeks, Edward Khutsishvili found his way to make an impact against the Hatters, connecting with Cleeland on a 19-yard touchdown to close the first half.

OFFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

-Despite the graduation of Eli Simonsen, UC Davis returns a large number of their offensive linemen from last season. Leading the group is senior center Zaire Collier, who was named a nominee for the Allstate Good Works Team.

-Other returners include Davis native AJ Hasson, David Main, Roice Cleeland, and Jayden Montanez.

-Consistency on the line proves to be paramount week after week as the Aggies have allowed only three sacks as a unit over the past two games (one at SMU, two vs. Stetson).

WIDE RECEIVERS NOTEBOOK

-Samuel Gbatu Jr. led the wide receiver unit yet again against Stetson, finishing with career-highs in receptions (10) and receiving yards (172). His 46-yard touchdown was his longest play of the season so far, and also his 25th career receiving touchdown, which ties him for fourth all-time in school history.

-Xzavior Guess had his most successful outing as an Aggie as the sophomore recorded two catches for 40 yards. The Huntington Beach native recorded a career-long 29-yard catch from Jackson Kollock in the fourth quarter.

DEFENSIVE LINE NOTEBOOK

-Rayne Mayo Jr. led the line with four tackles on Saturday night (three assisted, one solo). Jaden Few also added two tackles in the victory.

-Trent Carrade returned to action for the first time this season against Stetson, finishing with two tackles (one solo), one tackle for loss (-8 yards), and one sack (-8 yards).

LINEBACKER NOTEBOOK

-Porter Connors led the Aggies defensively against Stetson as the linebacker finished with a game-high 10 tackles, four of which were solo, one tackle for loss (-2 yards), and one forced fumble. The performance marked the sixth time in his career and the second time this season he has finished with ten total tackles or more. The forced fumble was his first of his career. The tackle for loss was his second this season.

-Nick Afato finished with seven tackles (one solo), along with 0.5 tackles for loss (-1 yard).

DEFENSIVE BACK NOTEBOOK

-Teeg Slone led the defensive backs statistically on Saturday, finishing with nine tackles, six of which were solo. The total marked a new career-high in tackles for the Utah State transfer.

-Brayden Rosa continues to find the ball, totaling seven tackles, including two solo tackles.

-Ty Richardson and Drew Cofield each recorded four total tackles, with each finishing with two solo tackles.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTEBOOK

-Robert Meyer went 1-for-2 on field goals against Stetson, missing his first opportunity from 42 yards at 5:02 in the opening quarter before converting on a 33-yarder at 5:56 in the third quarter.

-Meyer, who is originally from nearby Colfax, Calif., transferred to UC Davis this past offseason after serving as Missouri's kicker in 2025. Meyer converted on his first field goal as an Aggie at No. 17/17 SMU, drilling a 33-yarder with 3:35 left in the fourth quarter. It also marked the first field goal of the season for UC Davis as a team.

-Punter Dylan Mauro is back for the Aggies after totaling 1,750 yards last year. In his first game of 2026, Mauro pinned the Vikings with 293 punting yards, including two of over 50 yards. At No. 17/17 SMU, Mauro finished with 246 yards, including a long of 51 yards.

-Joseph Adema also returns as the team's primary holder.

NO. 11/11 UC DAVIS 45, STETSON 7

Sept. 19, 2026 | Davis, California | UC Davis Health Stadium | 15,270

It was a special night at UC Davis Health Stadium on Saturday, Sept. 19 as No. 11/11 UC Davis (3-1, 1-0 Big Sky) raced past Stetson (1-3), 45-7, to open the 20th season in the facility.

With the win, UC Davis moves to 48-24-2 in home openers all-time and has won 11 straight home openers dating back to 2016.

After forcing a three-and-out to begin the evening, UC Davis methodically drove down the field for its first points of the game, scoring the opening touchdown on a 6-yard plunge from Jordan Fisher. The touchdown capped off a 12-play, 75-yard drive for the Aggies.

The two teams traded possessions in the minutes to follow, but the Aggies struck again when Treyvor Cleeland found a streaking Samuel Gbatu, Jr. down the middle of the field for a 46-yard touchdown with 1:12 remaining in the fourth quarter, putting UC Davis up 14-0.

Moving into the second period, Zach Jones electrified the crowd at 8:59 by returning a Stetson punt 79 yards for his first-career punt return touchdown. The score extended the lead to 21-0 in favor of UC Davis.

The Aggie defense continued to dominate for the remainder of the quarter, with UC Davis getting the ball back for one final drive with 1:21 left. Cleeland showed his poise once more as the half wound down, this time finding Edward Khutsishvili in the end zone on a 19-yard touchdown with 16 seconds remaining. Following the strike, the Aggies rolled into halftime with a 28-0 advantage.

Coming out of the locker room, both sides stalled on offense until UC Davis took the ball back at the 9:27 mark. Robert Meyer added to the Aggie lead shortly thereafter, converting on his lone field goal of the night at 5:56 in the third quarter to push the score to 31-0.

Jones wasn't done creating magic on special teams as the senior housed his second punt return of the game at 3:07 in the third quarter. The Daly City native danced through the Stetson defense on the 61-yard return, putting UC Davis up 38-0.

The Hatters got on the scoreboard in the middle of the fourth quarter, crossing the goal line on a 39-yard touchdown from Thomas Von Grote to Anthony Benzija with 6:59 remaining in regulation.

Enjoying a successful night all around, Kai Acia joined the party by scoring his first-career touchdown with 33 seconds left. This touchdown would be the final points of the night for either side as UC Davis cruised to a 45-7 victory.
