TONIGHT'S GAME

■ Villanova returns home for the first time since the season opener to take on Colgate on Saturday afternoon during Family Weekend on campus. The game kicks off at 2:30 p.m. and will air live on ESPN+ and the Villanova Sports Radio Network.

■ Villanova won its seventh straight road game against FCS competition and its 21st straight regular season non-conference game over an FCS team with last week's 20-16 win at LIU.

■ Villanova has had success on the road both recently and over a much longer stretch. The Wildcats have won seven straight road games against FCS competition since last season and are 28-12 (.700) on the road in FCS games dating back to the start of the 2019 campaign. The longer stretch goes all the way back to 2008; since then Villanova is 65-34 (.657) away from home against FCS teams.

■ Villanova won for the sixth time in its last eight games in the state of New York last week.

■ Villanova quarterback **Pat McQuaide** led an 85-yard touchdown drive at the end of the LIU game last week. He was 6-of-7 through the air for 78 yards on the game-winning drive, which culminated on a 13-yard touchdown reception by junior running back **Ja'brriel Mace**.

■ Sopomore wide receiver **Brandon Binkowski** topped 100 yards in a game for the first time last week when he made six catches for 113 yards against LIU. Binkowski leads the Wildats with 259 receiving yards on the year.

GAME 5 NOTEBOOK: VILLANOVA VS. COLGATE

THE MATCHUP

- It is Family Weekend on campus and Villanova returns home for the first time since the season opener to host Colgate on Saturday afternoon. Kickoff is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. at Villanova Stadium as the teams meet for the fourth straight year and 10th time overall. The game will be broadcast on ESPN+ with **Jake Starr** and **Nick Mantegna** calling the action in the booth, and **Tessa Peloso** on the sidelines. The radio call with **Ryan Fannon** and **Michael Marcantonini** on the Villanova Sports Radio Network can be found on the iHeart radio app.

ABOUT VILLANOVA

- The first month of the 2026 season has been an aberrant one for Villanova. The four games played thus far have included three night games, two Friday night contests, two straight league games to start the year, and three straight road games since the season opener. It goes without saying that the Wildcats will be looking forward to the friendly confines of home this weekend. Villanova is 2-2 on the year and 1-1 in Patriot League play after tallying a 20-16 win over LIU in the closing minutes last week. The Wildcats continued to be nationally-ranked in both major FCS polls, including No. 23 in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and No. 22 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll.

ABOUT COLGATE

- Colgate is undefeated against FCS competition this season and even held a lead into the fourth quarter at FBS member Central Michigan earlier this month. The Raiders are 3-1 overall and 2-0 in Patriot League play after a 20-7 win at home over Colgate last week. The start to the season has lifted the Raiders into a national ranking in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll (No. 23t) and to the third team receiving votes outside of the top 25 in the Stats Perform rankings.

SERIES HISTORY

- Villanova has won eight of the previous nine meetings in the all-time series with Colgate, including a 24-17 victory at Villanova Stadium in the 2025 season opener. This is the fourth straight season that the teams are playing each other, but the first-ever matchup as conference opponents for the Wildcats and the Raiders. Six of the nine previous games in the series have taken place at Villanova Stadium. The only win by Colgate in the series came in the first-ever matchup between the teams. It took place in 1978 on the Main Line when the Raiders tallied a 20-14 victory.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Villanova is coming off three straight road games over the last three weeks, but chances are the Wildcats don't mind the travel too much. That is because last week's 20-16 win at LIU was the team's seventh straight road win since last season over FCS opponents. Villanova's trend of success on the way from home looks even better when examining it over a longer stretch. The team is 28-12 (.700) on the road versus FCS competition since the start of the 2019 season. Going back even further, the Wildcats are 65-35 (.657) away from home against FCS foes since the beginning of the 2008 campaign.

NON-CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

- Villanova has won 21 consecutive regular season non-conference games against FCS teams, a streak which continued last week with the Wildcats tallying a 20-16 win at LIU. The team's last regular season non-conference loss versus an FCS foe was back in 2015 when Villanova lost to Penn in the fourth game of that season. The streak of 21 straight wins began with the following year's season opener. In all, the Wildcats own a 29-6 (.829) mark against FCS non-conference opponents since 2016, including both the regular season and the playoffs.

GAME 5 NOTEBOOK: VILLANOVA VS. COLGATE

NEW YORK, NEW YORK

- Villanova has won six of its last eight games in the state of New York, including the last three in a streak which was extended by the 20-16 win at LIU last week. The stretch of three straight wins also included victories at Colgate and at Stony Brook during the 2024 season. Head coach **Mark Ferrante**, a native of upstate New York near Syracuse, is 7-4 in his home state as a head coach. The next road game for the Wildcats will be a return trip to the Empire State to play Fordham on October 17.

GAME-WINNING DRIVE

- Villanova fell behind by a 16-13 score in the closing minutes of last week's game at LIU when the Sharks made a field goal with 2:44 to play. A penalty against the Wildcats on the ensuing kickoff led to VU starting from its own 15-yard line with 2:36 left. Sixth year quarterback **Pat McQuaide** engineered an efficient game-winning touchdown drive as he marched the Wildcats down the field for 85 yards on eight plays. After throwing an incompletion on the first play of the drive, McQuaide completed six consecutive passes for 78 yards on the drive. He also escaped a sack and picked up seven yards on the ground to help keep the momentum going during the possession. The culmination of the drive was a 13-yard touchdown pass from McQuaide to junior running back **Ja'briel Mace** with 1:08 to play.

POSITIVE SIGNS FROM THE LOUISVILLE GAME

- There were positive signs for Villanova in its September 11 game against nationally ranked ACC member Louisville. Early in the game, the Wildcats engineered a 12-play, 58-yard scoring drive on their first possession which culminated in a 35-yard field goal to tie the game at 3-3. It was only the third time in the last nine matchups against FBS teams that Villanova scored points in the first half. The Wildcats went on to amass 253 yards of total offense in the contest, the fourth time in the nine most recent FBS games that they have topped 250 yards.

MCQUAIDE AND MACE CONNECT FOR 65-YARD TD AT LOUISVILLE

- Villanova has played 29 games against FBS competition since 1988 and, in those games, has run just shy of 2,000 total offensive plays from scrimmage (1,984 exactly). Only one of those plays has been for 60 yards or longer, and it came last week against Louisville when sixth year quarterback **Pat McQuaide** hit junior running back **Ja'briel Mace** along the sideline for a 65-yard touchdown. It is the longest reception of Mace's career and ties McQuaide's longest touchdown pass in a Villanova uniform. Prior to last week's game, the longest offensive play for the Wildcats in recent years against an FBS foe was a 52-yard pass from **Connor Watkins** to **Rayjuon Pringle** at Penn State in 2021.

THE POWER OF 10



In July, the Patriot League unveiled its football-specific brand identity and slogan, "The Power of 10," marking the beginning of A New Era of Patriot League Football as the League enters the 2026 season with 10 football-playing institutions for the first time in its 41-year history.

"The Power of 10" campaign reflects both the strength coming with expansion and the collective success that has long defined Patriot League football, creating one of the nation's premier FCS conferences.

Collectively, the Patriot League's 10 football members have won two FCS national championships, advanced to 12 FCS national semifinals and reached the quarterfinal round 22 times, earning 42 FCS postseason wins.

GAME 5 NOTEBOOK: VILLANOVA VS. COLGATE

PATRIOT LEAGUE DEBUT

■ A transformational new chapter of Villanova football begins this season as the Wildcats make their highly anticipated debut as an associate member of the Patriot League. The match between Villanova and the Patriot League is a natural one both on and off the field, and the Wildcats were picked to finish atop the league standings in a preseason poll of league head coaches.

PLAYING THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

■ Villanova may be new to the Patriot League this season, but it has played eight of the the other nine teams in the conference at least once since 2015. The only member of the conference that the Wildcats have not faced in a long time is Georgetown, who will visit Villanova Stadium in the regular season finale later this year. Despite their memorable matchups on the hardwood, the Wildcats and the Hoyas have not faced each other in football since 1950.

■ Villanova began the year having won its previous 20 games against the Patriot League since a 2013 loss to Fordham. The streak did not include games that the Wildcats played against Richmond and William & Mary when the teams were conference opponents in CAA Football.

POLLING PLACES

■ Villanova comes in this week at No. 23 in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and No. 22 in the AFCA FCS Coaches Poll. This season marks the 34th time in the last 39 years that the Wildcats have been nationally ranked at some point during the season.

■ Villanova has been ranked in each of the last 42 national polls dating back to the middle of the 2023 season (October 16 poll). This is the fourth-longest active streak among FCS teams.

■ Villanova ranks third among all teams in FCS history (since 1978) for the number of weeks appearing in the national media poll. In their 344 weeks being nationally ranked, the Wildcats have been in the top 10 for a total of 159 weeks (11th most all-time) and have been ranked in the top five for 67 weeks.

DOUBLE DIGIT WINS

- Villanova is coming off a 12-3 season in 2025 which tied the second-most wins in a season in school history. It was the fourth time in the last five years that the Wildcats have won 10 or more games. The only two FCS teams with 10+ wins in four of the last five seasons are Villanova and defending national champion Montana State.

SUPER SIX

- Villanova has been one of the dominant teams in the FCS over the last six seasons and has a 50-20 (.714) overall record in that span (2021-26). The .714 winning percentage ranks seventh among current FCS teams during this stretch.

YOU WILL REMEMBER ME (FOR A CENTURY)

- The 2026 season is the 100th year of hosting intercollegiate athletic events in venerable old Villanova Stadium, which was officially dedicated on October 8, 1927. Villanova has an all-time record of 278-114-5 (.707) at Villanova Stadium, including a 29-4 home record over the last five years. A 100th birthday celebration for the venue is being planned for next season.

PRESEASON PATRIOT LEAGUE POLL

- Villanova was picked to finish atop the Patriot League standings in its inaugural season in the league in a preseason poll of league head coaches. The Wildcats received seven first-place votes (Lehigh received the other three) and a total of 79 points in the poll to come in four points ahead of defending league champion Lehigh. Villanova defeated Lehigh, 14-7, in the second round of last year's FCS playoffs.

GAME 5 NOTEBOOK: VILLANOVA VS. COLGATE

4,000 AND TOP 10 FOR MCQUAIDE

- Through his first 19 games in a Villanova uniform, sixth year quarterback **Pat McQuaide** has thrown for exactly 4,000 yards on the dot. McQuaide moved into 10th place in school history in career passing yards during last week's game at LIU. McQuaide is 304-of-509 (59.7%) through the air during his Wildcats career while throwing 30 touchdown passes compared with eight interceptions. He is the 11th passer in school history to reach the milestones of 300 completions and 30 touchdown passes.
- McQuaide has thrown 37 completions over the last two games, including a season high 19 in the win at LIU last week (19-of-27, 223 yards, one touchdown). He led the Wildcats on an eight-play, 85-yard game-winning drive in the fourth quarter which culminated with his 13-yard touchdown pass to junior running back **Ja'briel Mace** with 1:08 to play.
- McQuaide's next pass completion will be the 700th of his collegiate career. His overall collegiate totals entering play against Colgate this week are 699-of-1195 for 8,414 yards with 57 touchdowns and 30 interceptions.

MACE IN YOUR FACE

- Junior running back **Ja'briel Mace** had his best game of the season in last week's win at LIU and he finished the day with 170 all-purpose yards. He rushed for a season best 97 yards and a touchdown, including a 20-yard scoring run in the second quarter, and later caught the game-winning 13-yard touchdown pass with 1:08 to play in the contest. Mace had 35 receiving yards and returned two kickoffs for a total of 38 yards in the game. He ranks seventh in school history with 1,126 career kickoff return yards.

1,600 AND TOP 20 FOR RAGLAND

- Junior running back **Isaiah Ragland** moved into 20th place in school history with 1,640 rushing yards at LIU last week. He reached the top 20 in the Villanova record book on a seven-yard run in the first quarter and finished the game with 11 carries for 43 yards. His career totals are 344 carries for 1,640 yards and eight touchdowns to go along with 26 receptions for 214 yards and one additional score. The next person that Ragland can pass on the Wildcats career rushing list is **Anthony Cowsette (1993-96)** who rushed for 1,689 yards. Ragland needs 310 rushing yards to crack Villanova's top 15 all-time and would need 360 yards to reach 2,000 rushing yards for his career.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

GAME 5 NOTEBOOK: VILLANOVA VS. COLGATE

BIG GAME BINKOWSKI

- Sophomore wide receiver **Brandon Binkowski** topped 100 receiving yards in a game for the first time in his collegiate career in last week's win at LIU. He had a career high six catches for 113 yards in the contest, including three receptions for more than 20 yards and two for a combined total of 38 yards on the Wildcats game-winning drive in the fourth quarter. It was the first time since the Elon game last season that a Villanova player had three catches for more than 20 yards in a single game.
- Binkowski has nearly tripled his output from 15 games as a true freshman last season. He had 11 catches for 99 yards in 15 games played in 2025, but in just four games this year already has 18 receptions for 259 yards and a touchdown. Binkowski ranks third in the Patriot League in receiving yards this season, while he and fellow sophomore wide receiver **Braden Reed** are tied for fourth in the league with an average of 4.5 receptions per game.

PUNT RETURNS APLENTY

- The first drive of last week's game at LIU ended with a Sharks punt which sophomore **Braden Reed** returned for 30 yards. It was the longest punt return of the season for Reed, who moved into 10th place in school history with 351 career punt return yards. Reed is averaging 14.0 yards per punt return on 25 returns for 351 yards. Reed's average of 14.0 yards per punt return ranks fourth in school history, while he needs 49 more punt return yards to become the seventh Villanova player with 400 or more career punt return yards.

BURSEY ONTO THE SCENE

- Sophomore linebacker **Omari Bursey** has emerged as one of the top defensive players in the FCS this season. He ranks second in the Patriot League and in the top 15 nationally in both total tackles (42) and solo tackles (25) through four games played. He averages 10.5 tackles per game and led the country through the first two weeks of the season with 29 total stops in games against William & Mary and Bucknell. Bursey was named the Stats Perform FCS Defensive Player of the Week and the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Week after he made 14 stops at Bucknell.

CABALLERO'S CAREER DAY

- Junior linebacker **Christian Caballero** recorded his first career double digit tackle game in last week's LIU win. He made seven solo stops and three assisted tackles in the contest, including 3.0 tackles for loss. Caballero missed the second game of the season with an injury but still ranks second on the team with 26 tackles on the year.

SEALING THE OUTCOME

- Sophomore safety **Jamie Tyson** sealed the win at LIU last week when he intercepted a tipped pass with just over a minute to play. Tyson finished the day with five total tackles and the third interception of his career. Tyson has been a consistent player for Villanova in the earlygoing of the 2026 season. He ranks third on the team with 22 total tackles.

A BOOST AT LINEBACKER

- Villanova has gotten a lift in the past two games from the emergence of redshirt freshman linebacker **Walker Murray**. The contests against Louisville and LIU in the past two weeks are the only two that Murray has played in during his collegiate career. Still, he made 15 total tackles in the two games, including eight at Louisville and seven last week.
- The three starters at linebacker for the Wildcats last week — Murray, sophomore **Omari Bursey** and junior **Christian Caballero** — combined for 25 tackles and 3.5 tackles for loss against LIU.

Three Villanova student-athletes have been named Rhodes Scholars, with numerous others earning Academic All-America distinction. Villanova's athletics history includes 21 NCAA team national championships, as well as 140 conference championships. In addition, at least one Villanovan has participated in every Summer Olympics since 1948. Villanova is a member of the BIG EAST Conference, Patriot League, Coastal Athletic Association (Rowing) and Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (Water Polo).

ACADEMICS

The GPA for more than 550 student-athletes in the Spring 2026 semester was a new record of 3.549, making it 17 straight semesters that student-athletes have had a GPA of 3.3 or higher. Success in the classroom has been across-the-board for Villanova Athletics, with 90 percent of all student-athletes compiling a GPA of 3.0 or higher and 75 student-athletes from 19 sports maintaining a perfect 4.0 GPA.

HERE IS THE KICKER

- Junior kicker **Dominic LeBlanc** leads the Patriot League in field goal percentage (85.7%) and ranks second in the league with six field goals made through the first month of the season. LeBlanc made a pair of field goals and two extra points last week, while missing on what would have been a career long 49-yard attempt.

STRONG START FOR MYERS

- Junior punter **Luke Myers** is off to a strong start to the season in his first year in this role for the Wildcats. Myers has 16 times for an average of 41.4 yards per punt and six attempts which were downed inside the opponent's 20-yard line. In the Louisville game two weeks ago Myers punted eight times for an average of 44.1 yards, including punts of 60 yards and 64 yards in the first half. He has three attempts for 60 yards or longer this season. Four of Myers' punts at Louisville were downed inside the 20-yard line, the first time that had happened in a Villanova game since the final contest of the 2024 season.

PLAYING WITH EXPERIENCE

- The members of this year's Villanova roster have played a total of 1,151 games in their college football careers. There are 14 members of the roster who have appeared in 30 games or more and four who have appeared in 40 or more games. The team leaders in games played are the trio of running back **Julian Glantz**, defensive end **Capri Martin** and quarterback **Pat McQuaide** who have each played in 43 career games.

WELCOME TO THE MAIN LINE

- The newcomers to the Villanova roster this season include five transfers who all have previous college football experience. The five incoming transfers include cornerback **Mikey Allen (Southern Utah)**, linebacker **Tyler Cain (Slippery Rock)**, tight end **Brody Eaton (Marist)**, wide receiver **Jake Hilton (Wisconsin-River Falls)** and kicker **Dominic LeBlanc (Tennessee Tech)**. All five players appeared on the Wildcats depth chart to begin the season.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Villanova has played 1,235 games in its history and those contests have yielded 673 unique scores. It isn't hard to tell how much the game of football has changed over the years. The most commonly repeated score in school history is 6-0 which has occurred 23 times, including 11 Villanova wins by that score and 12 losses.

PRESEASON ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE

- Villanova had five selections to the Preseason All-Patriot League team in the poll of league head coaches. The selections on offense include running back **Ja'briel Mace**, wide receiver **Braden Reed** and right guard **Chris McCullers**, while the defensive selections are linebacker **Omari Bursey** and defensive end **Capri Martin**.

WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Junior running back and kick returner **Ja'briel Mace** is among 30 offensive players nationwide, including three from the Patriot League, who were named to the Walter Payton Award Preseason Watch List on Tuesday morning. The watch list was announced by Stats Perform for the annual award which is presented to the national offensive player of the year in Division I FCS college football. This is the third straight year that Villanova has had a player named to the initial watch list for the Walter Payton Award.

NATIONAL PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR MACE

- In addition to being named to the Watch List for the Walter Payton Award, running back and kick returner **Ja'briel Mace** was named a Stats Perform Preseason All-American and landed a spot on the 2027 East-West Shrine Bowl 1000. Last season Mace became the second player in Villanova history to average more than 30 yards on kickoff returns over a full season. He had 23 returns for 735 yards and an average of 31.96 yards per return, with both his total return yards and his average return ranking him second among all FCS players. Mace also was the first player in the country last season to return two kick-offs for touchdowns, a feat he accomplished twice in a three-game span with a 100-yard return against William & Mary on September 27 followed two weeks later by a 97-yard return for a score at Elon.

An explosive runner in any role on the field, Mace was the Wildcats leading rusher in a deep corps of running backs last season. He ran for 946 yards and 11 touchdowns while averaging 7.39 yards per carry, including three games with over 100 yards and three with two or more rushing touchdowns. Mace had a historic performance against Towson on November 8 last season when he broke Brian Westbrook's single game record for rushing yards. Mace had 291 yards and scored all four Villanova touchdowns in a 28-10 victory. He followed that performance two weeks later with 165 yards and two scores in the regular season finale against Sacred Heart, then had 151 rushing yards and a touchdown in an FCS playoff quarterfinal win at Tarleton State.

ACADEMIC HIGHLIGHTS

NCAA ACADEMIC DATA

■ Villanova had a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score of 986 in the latest data released by the NCAA in May 2026. This score is 27 points above the national average for FCS programs.

■ New data on the NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) was released in November 2025 and Villanova recorded its fifth straight year with a score of 95 percent or higher.

ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

■ One of the highest honors that a student-athlete can achieve is to be named an Academic All-American, an award which encompasses both academic achievement as well as contributions on the field. Villanova has had 12 football student-athletes earn a total of 14 Academic All-America honors over the years.

CHI ALPHA SIGMA HONOR SOCIETY

■ Villanova is the Pennsylvania Alpha Delta Chapter of Chi Alpha Sigma, a national nonprofit academic honor society for collegiate student-athletes. The criteria for induction requires that a student-athlete be a junior or senior academically and have achieved a minimum cumulative grade point average of a 3.5. The football team had 17 honorees in the 2025-2026 induction class.

NFF HAMPSHIRE HONOR SOCIETY

■ The NFF Hampshire Honor Society is chosen annually and comprised of college football players from all divisions who each maintained a cumulative 3.2 GPA or better throughout their college careers. Members of the NFF Hampshire Honor Society are nominated by their respective schools and must have attained a 3.2 GPA or higher, have been a starter or contributor throughout the most recent season, and must be a senior, graduate student or grad transfer who competed in the most recent season.

ACADEMIC ALL-AREA TEAMS

■ In conjunction with the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the sports information directors at the colleges and universities in the Philadelphia area (PhillySIDA) name an Academic All-Area team and a football Performer of the Year each season. In the 20 years of the Academic All-Area program, which started with the 2005-06 academic year, the football team has had a total of 68 selections to the Academic All-Area Team. In addition, the Wildcats have had six Performers of the Year.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH MARK FERRANTE



It is a milestone year for Mark Ferrante in 2026 as he heads into his 10th season as the Thomas and Diane Treacy Endowed Football Head Coach and his 40th year overall with the Villanova football program. His four decades with the Wildcats include his time as head coach and 30 years as an assistant from 1987-2016, the last 18 of which were as assistant head coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of 286 victories and all 17 of the program's FCS playoff appearances during his Villanova tenure. He enters the 2026 season with a career head coaching record of 69-36 (.657) which includes five playoff appearances and two conference titles.

Villanova itself embarks on a transformational season in 2026 in its first year as an associate member of the Patriot League in football. A preseason poll of league head coaches predicted the Wildcats to finish atop the competitive conference standings as the Patriot League grows to 10 football members for the first time in its history.

The match between Villanova and the Patriot League is an excellent one both on and off the field and comes as Ferrante has consistently positioned the Wildcats as one of the top FCS programs in the country. Villanova begins the 2026 season as one just two FCS programs to have won 10+ games in at least four of the last five seasons. During that span (2021-25) the Wildcats have made four playoff appearances, including last year's incredible run to the semifinal round for only the fourth time ever. Villanova's overall record over the past five seasons is 48-18 (.727), including a 29-4 mark defending its home turf in Villanova Stadium.

Ferrante ranks second in school history in head coaching wins, while his .657 career winning percentage trails only Harry Stuhldreher (1925-35) and Clipper Smith (1936-42) among Wildcats head coaches who have held the position for three or more seasons. He passed Stuhldreher for second on the career wins list when Villanova defeated Sacred Heart in last year's regular season finale.

One of many highlights of the 2025 season was an 11-game winning streak which tied the second longest in program history. The streak began on September 27 with a victory over William & Mary and continued through the quarterfinal round of the playoffs when Villanova tallied a win at Tarleton State to advance to the FCS semifinals. During their playoff run the Wildcats knocked off three straight top 15 teams, including consecutive road victories over No. 4 Lehigh and No. 5 Tarleton State. It marked the first time since the 2010 playoffs that Villanova defeated top five foes in consecutive weeks away from home.

Villanova finished the 2025 season ranked No. 4 in the final Stats Perform FCS Top 25 and is at No. 8 in the 2026 preseason poll. The Wildcats have been ranked for 38 consecutive weeks since the middle of the 2023 season and have the fourth-longest active streak in the poll.

There was plenty of national and conference recognition to go around for the Wildcats last year. The team's accolades included offensive lineman Temi Ajio-tutu and kick returner Ja'briel Mace each being named first team All-Americans. Villanova had a total of five Stats Perform All-America selections, including the pair of first team honors to go along with a third team pick in linebacker Shane Hartzell and a pair of freshman All-America honorees in punt returner Braden Reed and safety Anthony Hawkins. Mace was named the CAA Football Special Teams Player of the Year and the Wildcats had 13 total all-conference selections for the first time since 2010.

One of the themes of Ferrante's head coaching tenure has been his ability to keep his teams largely intact throughout the COVID pandemic and the changing landscape of college sports. Villanova began the 2021 season with 75 out of 85 players returning from the previous Spring, while the members of the 2025 team had combined to play in more than 1,900 college football games by the end of the season. Experience wins, and Nova Nation has taken notice. Villanova's average attendance for five regular season home games in 2021 was its highest mark since 2013 and represented a 23 percent increase from 2019 prior to the pandemic. The increased attendance included the Wildcats first home sellout crowd since 2015 during the 2021 Family Weekend game against Richmond.

VILLANOVA FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

MARK FERRANTE / VILLANOVA COACHING STAFF

Ferrante has continually stressed the importance of his student-athletes coming to Villanova for a complete collegiate experience which includes excellence in their academic pursuits. In his first nine years as head coach, the Wildcats have been the winner of the CAA Football Team Academic Excellence Award five times. The award is presented to the team with the highest GPA in the conference each academic year and Villanova has been a repeat winner of the honor in each of the last four years spanning the 2022-23 through 2025-26 academic years.

The football program set and tied its highest overall NCAA Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a mark of 96 percent in both 2022 and 2023, while the team has had a mark of at least 95 percent in five consecutive years.

During the 2025-26 academic year, the Wildcats had 70 student-athletes selected to the CAA Football Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll during the Fall semester and another 65 honorees for the Spring 2026 grading period. There were 15 student-athletes who had a perfect 4.0 GPA in one of the two semesters, while Villanova had a total of 31 selections to the CAA High Honors (3.7+ GPA) and High Honors with Distinction (4.0 GPA) lists for the Spring semester.

Ferrante leads one of the nation's elite FCS programs after playing an instrumental role in the Wildcats rise to national prominence. He has been a part of the coaching staff for all 17 of Villanova's appearances in the FCS playoffs, including the 2009 national championship season and a 2010 semifinal appearance while serving as the Assistant Head Coach on Andy Talley's staff. Ferrante has been a part of Villanova teams that have won eight CAA titles, three Lambert Meadows Cups and three ECAC Team of the Year awards.

Ferrante's success during his years as an assistant coach was recognized by others outside the Villanova program. At the end of the 2015 season, he was named the FCS Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). This award was first presented in 1997 and was created to honor assistant coaches who excel in community service, commitment to student-athletes and on-field coaching success.

The characteristics that earned Ferrante the Assistant Coach of the Year award exemplify his dedication to all facets of a complete student-athlete experience. Since he arrived on the Main Line prior to the 1987 season, Villanova Football student-athletes have been named Academic All-Americans on 12 occasions.

That honor is one of the top accolades a collegiate student-athlete can earn, and the Wildcats additionally had four student-athletes be named the CAA Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year in a span of nine years. Each year the NCAA recognizes programs that have a multi-year Academic Progress Rate (APR) score that ranks within the top 10 percent of their sport nationwide. Villanova earned this award nine times in the first 14 years of the APR program.

Ferrante was involved in all aspects of the Villanova program during his time as an assistant on Andy Talley's staff. On the field he coached the offensive line for 27 seasons and developed a unit that was perennially one of the best in CAA Football. Over the years he coached three All-Americans, 11 All-East performers and 15 first team all-conference selections. The offensive line had 17 All-CAA selections in a nine-year span, including three-time first team honoree Ben Ijalana along with first team selections Brant Clouser (2010), Dan Shirey (2011) and Vince Kowalski (2014).

Two of Ferrante's players went on to be selected in the NFL Draft. Ijalana was a second round selection by the Indianapolis Colts in 2011 and Brad Seaton was picked in the seventh round by the Tennessee Titans in 2017. Ijalana was a two-time All-American (2009, 2010) and a three-time first team All-CAA selection during his collegiate career. Villanova reached the FCS playoffs in each of his last three seasons on the team, winning the 2009 national title and advancing to the semifinal round a year later. Seaton was a second team CAA Football All-Conference selection in 2016 when the offensive line enabled the Wildcats to average 206.3 rushing yards and 378.7 yards of total offense per game. Villanova ranked third in the CAA and 24th nationally in rushing offense in addition to ranking fourth in the league in total offense and fifth with a scoring average of 24.4 points per game.

Following the end of his playing career Ferrante joined Talley's staff at St. Lawrence and spent one season as the running backs coach in 1983. His other coaching stops before Villanova include coaching the running backs at Wagner (1984) and working on the coaching staff at Lafayette (1985-86).

Ferrante and his wife, Georgea, reside in Phoenixville, Pa. The couple has a son, Jimmy, who earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova in 2018.



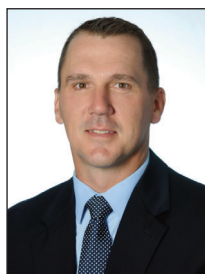
