### **Head Coach**

### **Travis Hudson:**

Coach Hudson just finished his 28th season at the helm of the Lady Toppers. As WKU's all-time winningest volleyball coach, he has been named a National Coach of the Year Finalist in 2002, 2005, 2012, 2016, 2017. & 2019 and most recently earned the C-USA Coach of the Year award in the fall of 2022. Since 2000, Hudson has directed the Lady Toppers to an impressive 722-222 record and has appeared in the NCAA tournament 15 times since 2002. This past season, he led WKU volleyball to the Conference USA Regular Season Championship and advanced to the NCAA tournament for the 11th time since 2010 with an at-large bid. His team also advanced to the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the NCAA tournament for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in school history and in the spring of 2021, he led his team to the program's first ever Sweet 16. While at WKU, he has coached his team to 17 conference championships in the last 21 years and has guided his team to 20 or more wins in the last 23 consecutive seasons. He has extensive camp experience, staffing some of the best camps in the Southeastern United States.

# Director of Operations Kristi Griffin:

Coach Griffin just completed her 14<sup>th</sup> season with the Lady Topper volleyball program. Her first 11 seasons were as an assistant coach and the last 3 have been as the Director of Volleyball Operations. She has been a part of 11 regular season conference championships, 9 conference tournament championships, 11 NCAA tournament appearances while advancing to the NCAA tournament 2<sup>nd</sup> round 7 times and the NCAA Sweet 16 in the spring of 2021. She has run numerous successful volleyball camps for the last 14 years as the camp director for the Lady Topper volleyball program.

# Associate Head Coach Craig Bere:

Coach Bere completed his eighth season as an assistant coach with the WKU volleyball program and was recently elevated to the Associate Head Coach position. He helped guide the team to the C-USA Regular Season Championship in the 2022 fall season. Bere has helped this team to 7 regular season conference championships and 6 conference tournament championships in his tenure at WKU. As an assistant at WKU, his team has also advanced to the NCAA 2<sup>nd</sup> round 5 times and the Sweet 16 once since joining the staff in 2015. In addition to his 29 years of DI coaching experience, he also has extensive club and camp experience running and working volleyball camps throughout the country.

### Jena Otec:

Jena Otec was hired as WKU's newest assistant coach in January of 2023. She was an assistant coach at Eastern Michigan for a year before making the move to WKU and was an All-American libero at Purdue prior to the start of her collegiate coaching career. While playing collegiately, she spent five years coaching with The Academy Boiler Juniors, a Lafayette, IN-club volleyball organization. She led her teams to numerous championships during her time coaching and has also mentored multiple nationally ranked junior players. As Purdue's starting libero, Otec earned Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2020 and collected All-American honors following both the 2020 and 2021 campaigns. Jena has over 6 years of camp experience working numerous camps across the country during both her playing and coaching careers.

### 2022 Season in Review:

The Lady Topper volleyball team put together its 23<sup>rd</sup> straight 20+ win season with a 29-4 overall record and a 14-0 conference record to earn the program's 8th regular season Conference USA championship. They also earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament for their 11th NCAA tournament appearance since 2010. The Lady Toppers then advanced to the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the NCAA tournament for the 7<sup>th</sup> time in program history. In addition, they earned 4 C-USA All-Conference selections, the C-USA Player of the Year and Freshman of the Year awards, 4 All-Region selections including the Region Player of the Year, and an All-American 2<sup>nd</sup> Team selection. WKU was also ranked in EVERY National Top 25 Poll throughout the season climbing as high as #21. This marks the 11th season since 2011 the Lady Toppers have been ranked in the Top 25 Poll.
